Are We Going to Make a Big Deal Every Seven and a Half Years?

The novel idea that Jews across the world should study the same *daf* of the Talmud each day, with the goal of completing the entire Talmud in 7 ½ years (2,711 days), was proposed by Rabbi Meir Shapiro, זצ"ל, a dynamic leader of world Jewry in the early 20th century. The first cycle of *Daf Yomi* began on the first day of Rosh Hashanah 5684 (September 11, 1923).

On the 9th of Kislev, 5743- November 25th, Thanksgiving Day in 1982- Rabbi Yossie Stern, ע"ה, convinced a few CBY *ba'alei batmit* to "get with the program" and they began studying *ברכות*, the beginning of the 9th *Daf Yomi* cycle. And here we are, 37 years later, approaching January 4th, the end of the 13th cycle. And yes, it's still a "big deal."



Can you guess the day of the week? The time (w/an accuracy of +/-6 minutes)? An estimated 60 individuals currently participate in Bnai Yeshurun's *Daf Yomi* program, about half of whom rise well before 5:00 am, to join in our daily 5:30 am shiur in the Beis Medrash. (You probably couldn't care less but participants in the morning shiur should be able to deduce from the photo that it was very likely taken on a Monday within +/- 6 minutes of 5:52am.)

Many Bnai Yeshurun members will attend the large *siyum* celebration at MetLife Stadium on New Year's Day. They will brave the cold weather and join close to 100,000 others in a unique manifestation of dedication to תלמוד תורה and Jewish אחדות.

Bnai Yeshurun has its own plans. This cycle of learning actually ends on Shabbat, January 4th. On that Friday evening, at 7:30 pm, we are planning to celebrate the occasion with a special *tisch* to be held in our Beis Medrash. At that time, we will make our formal *siyum*, listen to *divrei Torah* from Rabbi Pruzansky and Rabbi Weinberger, sing *zemirot*, enjoy *kugel* and *cholent*, etc.

Bnai Yeshurun's *Siyum HaShas* will be sponsored by Beth and Ronnie Stern and family in memory of Mrs. Vera Liebling ע"ה and Mr. Chaim Stern ע"ה.
