CBY Hosts Chaim Silberstein Founder of Keep Jerusalem

This Shabbat, Bnai Yeshurun is hosting Chaim Silberstein, founder and president of the Israeli organization, **אם-אשכנז**-Keep Jerusalem, will be speaking at the 8:30 am Ashkenaz and at the 9:15 *minyanim*, and between *mincha* and *maariv*. His morning talks are on the subject *When Terror is Personal and Why We Need a United Jerusalem*. In the afternoon Mr. Silberstein will discuss *The Future of Jerusalem According to Jewish Sources and in Light of the Upcoming Trump "Deal of the Century."*



Holder of an MBA from Hebrew University, Silberstein is also the president of Jerusalem Capital Development Fund, an organization dedicated to reclaiming and strengthening the Jewish presence in eastern (historic) Jerusalem, greater Jerusalem and parts of *Yesh'a*. He was formerly a senior advisor to the Israel Minister of Tourism and has three decades of experience marketing high tech, real estate and pro-Israel advocacy. He was involved with several of CBY's missions to Israel and provided a geopolitical perspective to the tours.

Tragically, in December 2018, Silberstein's pregnant daughter was one of seven Israelis wounded in a drive-by terrorist shooting. She gave birth in emergency Caesarean-section surgery, but the baby, who was treated in intensive care, lived for only three days. Silberstein has demanded stronger government response to such attacks and other acts of terror.
