Sunday Night Movie - Denial

In connection with yesterday's (כ"ז ניסן) commemoration of יום השואה, CBY's Adult Education Committee has arranged for a special screening of the acclaimed movie, *Denial*, on this Sunday evening, May 5th, at 7:30 in our Social Hall. Based on Dr. Deborah Lipstadt's book, *History on Trial: My Day in Court with a Holocaust Denier*, the film recounts her legal battle for historical truth against those who deny or distort the events of the Holocaust. The film will be followed by a talk by noted Jewish film critic, Dr. Eric Goldman.



Denial tells the story Dr. Lipstadt's (portrayed by Academy Award winner Rachel Weisz) legal battle for historical truth against David Irving (British Academy of Film and Television Arts (BAFTA) Award nominee Timothy Spall), who accused her of libel when she declared him a Holocaust denier. In the English legal system, in cases of libel, the burden of proof is on the defendant. Lipstadt and her legal team, led by Richard Rampton (Academy Award nominee Tom Wilkinson), had to prove the essential truth that the Holocaust occurred. The film, a 2016 British-American drama, was directed by Emmy Award winner Mick Jackson and adapted for the screen by BAFTA and Academy Award nominated writer David Hare.



Following the screening, there will be informed remarks by Dr. Eric Goldman, Jewish movie expert and, coincidentally, a classmate of Deborah Lipstadt. Goldman teaches at Yeshiva University and Fairleigh Dickinson University and is founder of Ergo Media, a distributor of Jewish cinema. He has graduate degrees in Contemporary Jewish Studies and Theater Arts from Brandeis and a Ph.D. in Cinema Studies from NYU.

Dr. Goldman has co-hosted on the Turner Classic Movies channel and has provided commentary on Israeli cinema for Turner's web streaming service, FilmStruck.

Reviewers have recommended the film for children above the age of 13. The subject matter is pretty intense (historical photos from WWII are shown, and there's much discussion of the Holocaust). But it's thought-provoking viewing for teens and adults, with themes including integrity, courage, and teamwork. Expect some swearing and a fair amount of drinking, but it might foster critical dialog between parents and teenagers about the Holocaust, anti-Semitism, and Jewish history.

There is no entry fee and the entire community is invited to attend.
