Rabbi Hayyim Angel to Serve As CBY Scholar in Residence

Rabbi Hayyim Angel will spend this Shabbat at Bnai Yeshurun as Scholar in Residence. He has published over 130 scholarly articles, primarily on the Bible, and is author or editor of sixteen books. His scholarship focuses on the interaction between traditional and academic approaches to Bible study. Following davening Shabbat morning, Rabbi Angel will speak, in the New Main Shul, on *The Ten Commandments in Classical Commentary and Contemporary Scholarship*. Shabbat afternoon before *mincha* (at 6:50 pm) his topic will be "*The Righteous Shall Live by His Faith: The Message of Habakkuk and Shavuot*". After *mincha* he will speak on *The Complex Layers of חסד in the Book of Ruth*.



Rabbi Angel has taught advanced Bible courses to undergraduate, graduate, and rabbinical students at Yeshiva University since 1996. He also serves as the Tanakh Education Scholar at Yeshivat Ben Porat Yosef in Paramus. He lectures widely in synagogues and schools throughout North America and consults with yeshivot worldwide to improve their Tanakh curricula.

The National Scholar of the Institute for Jewish Ideas and Ideals, Rabbi Angel lives in Teaneck with his wife and four children.

A prominent Bible educator in Israel, Rabbi Yaakov Beasley, wrote a thorough review of Rabbi Angel's work and methodology in April 2018. In his review, he refers to Rabbi Angel as "one of the great Tanakh teachers of our time."

Rabbi Angel previously served as Rabbi of Congregation Shearith Israel in New York City (1995-2013), and as Rabbinic Scholar at Congregation Kehilath Jeshurun in New York (2014-2017). He received his B.A. in Jewish studies Summa cum Laude from Yeshiva College, his M.A. in Bible from the Bernard Revel Graduate School, his M.S. in Jewish Education from the Azrieli Graduate School of Jewish Education, and his Rabbinical Ordination from the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary of Yeshiva University.
