## Progress on Several Fronts Reported At Annual "State of the Shul" Meeting

"Good progress on many fronts," was reported by President Ethan Keiser at CBY's annual general membership State of the Shul meeting on December 26. Shul treasurer Andrew Berkowitz reviewed the financials and indicated that, halfway through our fiscal year (which ends June 1<sup>st</sup>), we are "on plan" to meet our budget projections.

Keiser began with a brief discussion of each of the Executive Board's 2018 priorities

- Improve the Youth Experience
- Improve the Member Experience
- Increase the number of younger members
- Increase total (full and affiliate) membership
- Continue to improve and beautify the Shul facilities
- Streamline and increase donations to the Shul
- Increase the level of security in the Shul



Keiser also presented the results of the recent membership vote on adding additional security personnel and the concomitant \$100/family security assessment. The membership overwhelmingly approved the security plan by a vote of 234 to 62, a 79% majority! In response to a question about whether we had selected the best way to spend the additional security funds, Keiser responded that we are following the advice of both external consultants and our very knowledgeable internal team led by Adam Hirsch.

## Rabbi Binyomin Walfish a'h

We sadly record the passing of Rabbi "Yumi" Walfish, an early and influential member of Bnai Yeshurun. He joined Bnai Yeshurun in 1960 and for many years taught Talmud each *Shabbat* morning, following the *Hashkama minyan*. (We called it *Daf Yumi*.) Rabbi Walfish served as Executive Vice President of the Rabbinical Council of America for fifteen years and worked tirelessly for educational opportunities and special residences for the mentally disabled. In any event, he added, Hirsch would welcome suggestions as to additional or alternate security suggestions.

Berkowitz followed, reporting the status and projections for all major areas of expense and income. He summarized most elements with a “thumbs up” sign. He pointed out that the pledges for this year’s *Yom Kippur* Appeal were somewhat higher than in prior years and that the use of credit card payments of dues and other fees was slightly accelerating payments (and, reportedly, simplifying the process for our members). Also helping the financials were the additional donations made to refurbish the youth area.

Given the increasing popularity of the “Single Donor Men’s Club Kiddush,” whereby members may arrange for a Men’s Club Kiddush for a personal *simcha*, providing they invite the entire membership, a question was asked as to whether we should raise the fee so that the shul could get additional income. Berkowitz and Keiser explained that it was a delicate balance, since it’s a great service for both the *ba’alei simcha* and the entire membership.
