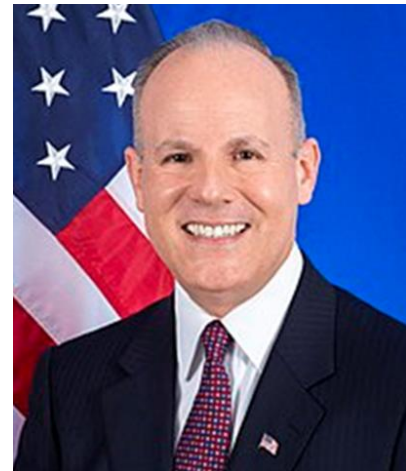

Special U.S. Envoy Elan Carr To Discuss American Efforts To Combat Growing Anti-Semitism

How serious is the recent rise in anti-Semitic incidents? What actions is the American government taking to combat this rise? On Tuesday, July 23, you will get a truly informed, first-hand answer to these and related questions, as the CBY Adult Education Committee brings Elan Carr, Special U.S. Envoy to Monitor and Combat Anti-Semitism, to Bnai Yeshurun. Since his appointment in February by Secretary of State Mike Pompeo, Carr is responsible for U.S. policies and projects aimed at countering anti-Semitism throughout the world.



Carr's personal background will likely prove to be fascinating to the Teaneck Jewish community. He is descended from both Ashkenazic and Iraqi Jewish families. His grandfather, who traced his lineage to Baghdad religious leader Abdallah Somekh (rosh yeshiva who taught Torah luminaries including the Chasam Sofer and the Ben Ish Chai), was prosecuted during the Iraqi show trials against Jewish community leaders in the mid-20th century.

Carr's mother, father, and stepfather are all immigrants to the United States, his mother having fled from Iraq to Israel, and his stepfather having fled from Nazi-occupied Bulgaria to pre-independence Israel, before both then moved to the United States. During Carr's Iraq War service, he led U.S. soldiers in lighting a Chanukah menorah in Saddam Hussein's presidential palace.

Carr earned his bachelor's degree in philosophy and political science at the University of California, Berkeley and his law degree at Northwestern University. He served as international president of Alpha Epsilon Pi (the world's largest primarily Jewish college fraternity, operating on nearly 200 college campuses in seven countries). Carr met his wife Dahlia, a physician, at a Jewish singles event. He served on the National Council of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) and was a voting member of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations.

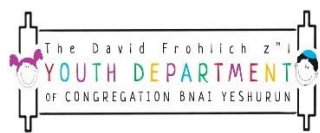
Guest Speaker Carr with Rabbi Pruzansky at the White House

Before his current appointment, Carr was a deputy district attorney in the Los Angeles County District Attorney's office. His work focused on prosecution of crimes committed by street gang members and, later, of crimes against special victims, including domestic violence, child molestation and sexual assault. Carr is also a JAG Corps officer in the U.S. Army Reserve and an Iraq War veteran. (The Judge Advocate General's Corps is the branch of the military concerned with military justice and military law.) In the 1990s, Carr spent a year in Israel, helping its Justice Ministry set up a public defender's office.
