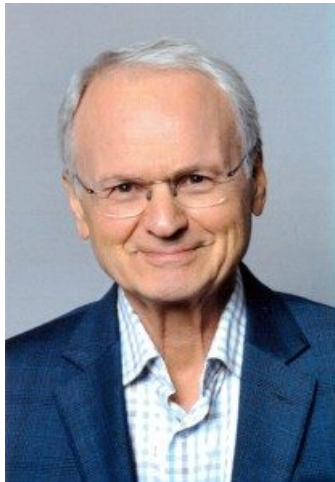

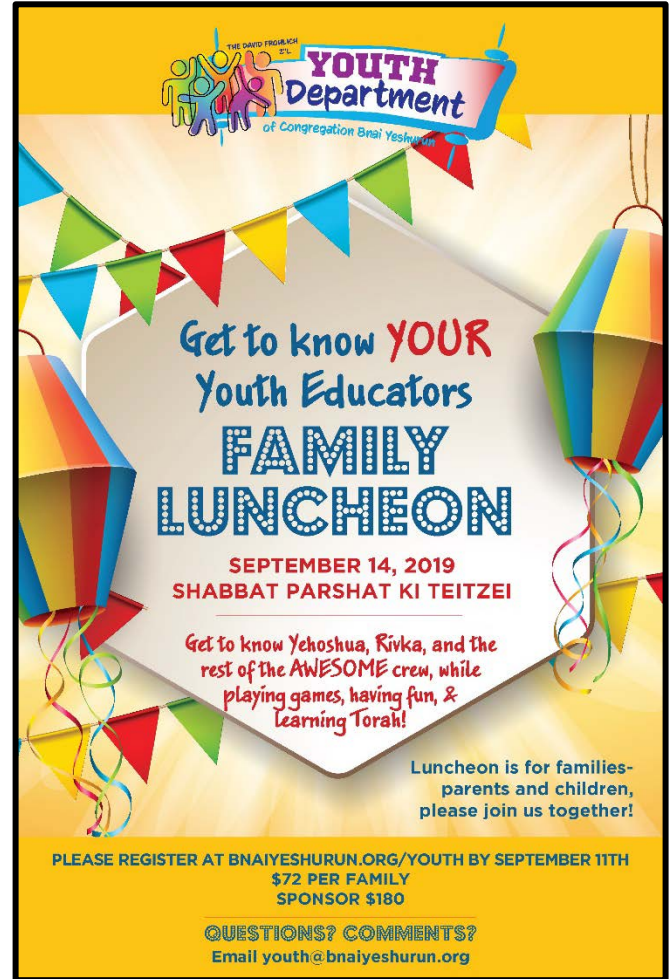
ZOA President to Discuss Current Trends of Anti-Semitism
