## CBY Plans Shabbat "Orah v'Simcha" To Enhance the Joy of Chodesh Adar

The Talmud (*Ta'anit 29a*) urges us to increase "joy" with the advent of the month in which we celebrate Purim, but does not prescribe specific activities or modalities. HaRav Chaim Shmuelevitz, zt"l, legendary *Rosh Yeshiva* of Mir, advocated dedicating extra hours to learn Torah, thereby "adding joy" to the month. Other *gedolim* devised their own formulas, but the clear focus was on enhancing joy through spiritual and religious actions.



In that spirit, Bnai Yeshurun will be celebrating *Shabbat Orah v'Simcha* on March 15-16, *Parshat VaYikra*, *Shabbat Zachor*. *Gabai Rishon* Chaim Kiss and his team are planning to use a template that worked so successfully when we celebrated *Shabbat Chanukah* together. Serving as the *Shaliach Tsiibur* for all the *tefillot* in the New Main will be Yumi Lowy, one of today's most talented and popular Jewish vocalists. Upon the

release of his debut album, Yumi's popularity among Jewish music aficionados of all backgrounds soared as he collaborated with numerous accomplished composers, including Yossi Green and Pinky Weber, to produce a dynamic album that sold thousands of copies within weeks of its release. Lowy will be accompanied by members of the Yedidim Choir. A group of talented Chassidic singers who spent *Shabbat Chanukah* with us, their renditions span a wide range of musical styles and moods. On Friday evening we will

host a *Tisch* with *zemirot*, and *divrei Torah* from Rabbi Pruzansky, Rabbi Zahtz, Rabbi Yosef Weinberger and special guest Rabbi Yoni Levin (*see photo*). In case you don't recognize him, Rabbi Levin, assistant rabbi at Congregation Aish Kodesh and the *Rosh Kollel* of



Emek Hamelech, grew up in Teaneck, son of Robin and Dr. David Levin. Thanks to our Men's Club for "catering" the *Tisch*. We will also have a special *Se'udah Shlisheet* to which all members of the family are encouraged to attend. Thanks in advance to Dovid Weinstein and his team for spearheading the *Se'udah Shlisheet* preparation. Special thanks to CBY families who are generously sponsoring this *Shabbat*.
