CBY Rabbinic Search Enters Next Phase

The process to select Bnai Yeshurun's next **דאטרה מרנ** entered a new phase last Wednesday evening, right on schedule. At its October 30th meeting, the Board of Directors accepted a lengthy and detailed report from the Rabbinic Transition Committee. The report, analyzing the results of a survey of our membership, explained our members' vision for the future of our shul and identified the skills and characteristics they want in our next Senior Rabbi. The Board then unanimously approved the official Position Description that invites applications.

The baton has now been passed to the Rabbinic Search Committee, who will screen, evaluate, and select a group of candidates from which the membership can ultimately select their new Senior Rabbi. It is planned that the congregation will meet the candidates in March. Also, right on schedule, President Ethan Keiser announced the formation of a Tribute Committee that will plan and manage the process to acknowledge and thank Rabbi and Karen Pruzansky for all they have done for our shul over the past twenty-five years.

The Transition Committee chair, Esti Kaminetzky, presented the Position Description and Michael Karlin presented the survey results. Other members of the team were Steven Becker, Frank Breslau, Chava Gamms, Clive Lipshitz, and David Zomick. In addition to the formal Position Description, the Transition Committee has given the Search Committee a large number of issues/questions that can be used in interviewing potential candidates.

The full report of the Transition Committee's Survey was shared with the shul membership earlier this week. Among the key requirements based on the membership's input:

- Must be able to appeal to and attract young families to our shul
- Should be warm and approachable, willing to invest in developing a personal connection with each of us;

- Should be a strong leader, an executive with a participative management style. He should be a unifier who can use his diplomatic skills to influence and to create consensus.

There is, of course, much more detail in the full report, which members are welcome to review.
