CBY Hosts Rabbi Mordechai Lebhar, Scholar of Moroccan Halacha, Minhagim

Rabbi Mordechai Lebhar, a scholar and teacher of Moroccan *halachot* and *minhagim*, will spend this Shabbat at Bnai Yeshurun as our Scholar-in-Residence. Rabbi Lebhar is currently Rosh Kollel at the LINK Kollel in Los Angeles and head of Machon Magen Avot, an organization focused on publishing *sefarim* authored by the *Hachamim* of Morocco, as well as contemporary *sefarim* that promote their Torah and *minhagim*.



This afternoon (Friday, January 3rd), Rabbi Lebhar will give a shiur after the 4:25 Moroccan Mincha Minyan on *Is There a Future for Sephardic Customs?*

Tomorrow morning before the Moroccan Shacharit Minyan, there will be an 8:30 am *shiur- Minhagim based on Superstitions; Do We Really Need Them?* A Kiddush will follow *minyan*. After 4:20 pm Mincha in the New Main, Rabbi Lebhar's subject will be *Running a Business According to Halacha on Shabbos: Easy Solutions to Big Problems*.

There will also be a *Melave Malka Shiur* with *Bakashot- The Glorious Rabbinic Conferences of the Rabbanim of Morocco in the 1940's*-7:30 pm at the Dahan home 576 N. Forest Drive, Teaneck.

Rabbi Lebhar was educated at prestigious *yeshivot* in Eretz Yisrael and America and has learned under some of the most prominent *poskim* of the generation, including Rav Tzvi Kushelevsky *shlit"a*, Rav Ezriel Aurebach *shlit"a* and, more recently, Rav Shlomo Miller *shlit"a*. Rabbi Lebhar is well-known for his popular *sefarim* on *minhagim*, and he writes daily *halacha* emails which reach thousands worldwide.
