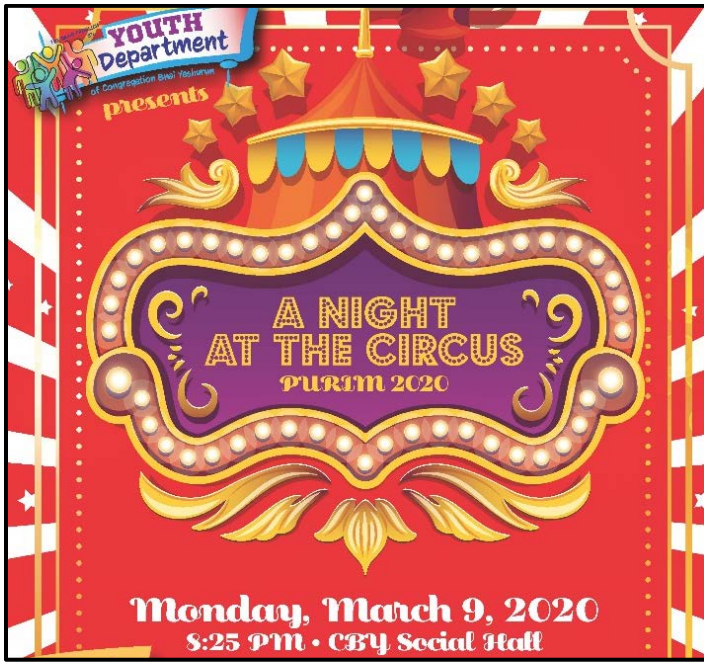

Community Announcements

- As everyone knows, it is vital that we all participate in the political process to make our community's voices heard by our elected officials. It has never been easier to register to vote, & for those so inclined, you can even choose to vote by mail-in ballot. The short Voter Registration Form is available in the shul office or at www.state.nj.us/state/elections/voter-registration.shtml. Lastly, please remember that this includes all voting-age children, even if they are away at school.
- There has been a dramatic rise in antisemitism; NJ has among the highest number of incidents in any state in the country. Our schools, synagogues & other communal institutions remain highly vulnerable. Teach NJ, a part of the OU, advocates for government funds for day schools. We are requesting a federal security grant increase from \$90 million to \$360 million, a state level grant increase from \$2 million to \$10 million, & that every school receive \$250 in security funds per student (up from \$150). This is an issue that requires the entire community to make a difference. We must work together to make sure that these security bills get passed. We can only ensure that these security measures get passed if we flood our government leadership with communications. - The polls are open! The voting period for the World Zionist Congress Election end on March 11. Go to www.zionistelection.com. This election will determine the allocation of approximately one billion dollars in funding over the next several years. Allocation is based on the percentage of delegates that each slate wins. The more votes for Torah & religious Zionist delegates, the more money for institutions that further those values. Rabbi & Karen Pruzansky are delegates on slate #1, Eretz Hakodesh. There are two other slates that would also further our values. Slate #4, the Orthodox Israel Coalition, & slate #11, the ZOA Coalition. Every Jew over the age of 18 is eligible to vote.
