

**Parshat Pinchas in “Hashtag” Form**

- Pinchas is rewarded for being a brave, zealous, **#CertifiedBoss**. HaShem grants him eternal priesthood **#TheBigKahuna** and lots of **#Peace**.
- HaShem commands us to teach the people of Midyan a lesson. **#DontBeMessin #SeeYaMidyana**
- Moshe and Elazar HaKohen perform a census and count all Jewish males who are above the age of twenty. **#CountDemHebrews #OneHenTwoDucks**
- Based on the census, the Jewish people were given portions of land in Eretz Canaan. The daughters of Tzelafchad (who’s father mysteriously passed away earlier **#WoodGatherer? #IThinkNot #Shabbos96b**) were upset that they didn’t receive a portion of land. **#NoSoup4You** They presented their argument before Moshe and HaShem, who ultimately agreed with them, so they received their father’s portion in Eretz Canaan! **#Soup4Us #Victory #WeCanDoIt #RespectfulDialoguin**
- HaShem tells Moshe to look into Eretz Canaan, from Har Avarim **#Sightseeing #WhattaView**. Yehoshua is officially appointed as Moshe’s successor **#HailToTheNewChief**
- The parshah ends off with korbanos, lots of them **#GimmeSumOfDatTamid**. We then learn about some of the holidays, as well as their respective korbanos **#CowsFavoriteKorban #MOOOOsaf #HappyChallahDays**.



**A Mini-Vort from the Szafranski Table to Yours!**

We have two famous examples in sefer Bamidbar where individuals felt left out and begged HaShem to ‘reconsider’ a certain halacha. In Parshas Behaalosecha, certain, anonymous, individuals who were

impure exclaimed: למה נגרע /why are we unable to offer the korban pesach? (9:7). This led to the unique halachos of Pesach Sheini. Then again, in our parshah, Bnos Tzelafchad (למה נגרע שם אבינו מותוך and ותרצה) asked: “מחלה נעה וחגלה ומלכה משפחתו/Why should our father’s name be lost to his clan just because he had no son!”

Rav Yehuda Herzl Henkin, in his sefer Chibah Yeseira (24:7), wonders why the Torah records the names of the Bnos Tzelafchad, but not the names of the Pesach Sheini crew. What was different between the two stories?

First of all, Rav Henkin notes, the daughters of Tzelofchad had no ulterior motives, they simply wanted their father’s **name**, reputation, and identity, to have a permanent place in Am Yisroel. Therefore, measure for measure, HaShem ensured that the **names** of Tzelofchad’s daughters would be individually and explicitly recorded in our parshah [Rav Henkin claims that this is also why the gemara in Baba Kama (92a) teaches that anyone who davens on behalf a friend for something, and the davener requires the same thing, the davener will be answered first]. Alternatively, says Rav Henkin, the daughters of Tzelofchad asked Moshe *before* they came into Eretz Yisroel, before it was necessary and directly relevant, but the band of impure individuals waited until the last minute. This showcased different levels of spiritual sensitivity.
