RABBI AARON LEIBTAG

February 28 - March 1 שבת פרשת תרומה

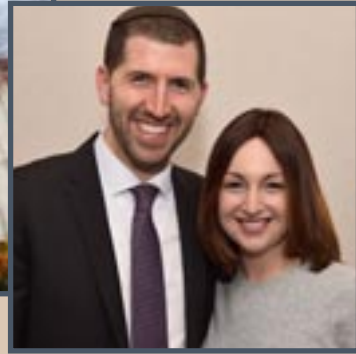
Rabbi Aaron Leibtag has been the Rabbi of Congregation Kehillath Jacob Beth Samuel (KJBS) in Chicago, Illinois for the past 11 years. Originally from Baltimore, Maryland, Rabbi Leibtag attended Yeshivat Shaalvim, received Semicha from Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Seminary of Yeshiva University while simultaneously earning a Masters of Education from the Azrieli School of Education and Administration. He served as Rabbinic Intern at Congregation AABJ&D in West Orange and at Keter Torah in Teaneck. Following his position in Teaneck, Rabbi Leibtag was selected to be part of the first cohort of Kollel Fellows at the Yeshiva University Torah Mitzion Kollel in Chicago, where he spent time both learning and teaching throughout the community.

In August 2009 Rabbi Leibtag assumed the position of Rabbi at KJBS, a 100 family shul located in Chicago. In this position, he has overseen education and programming for both youths and adults. He has worked to create a vibrant and energetic atmosphere through the various shiurim, programs and events he facilitated in the Shul. He has arranged scholar-in-residence weekends with world-renowned educators, lecturers and guest Chazanim. Rabbi Leibtag has initiated new learning, educational and social programs including a "Shul-Wide Siyum HaTanach Program," themed-learning on Shavuot, Parenting and Mental-Health Workshops with leading experts, Winter Mini-Series for Men and Women and a very popular annual Purim Shpiel.

Rabbi Leibtag is also a Middle School Gemara Rebbe and 8th Grade Boys Advisor at Hillel Torah North Suburban Day School where he oversees the Talmud and Dinim curriculums and is involved with the spiritual and Ruach programming for the entire middle school. Rabbi Leibtag is the recipient of the ATT Hartman Educator of the Year award and maintains close relationships with his students long after they have left his classroom. Rabbi Leibtag is a member of the RCA Executive Committee; Treasure of the cRc (Chicago Rabbinical Council) and sits on the Geirus Commission of the cRc.

Ayelet, (nee Feinberg) is a native of Queens, attended Stern College, received her RN degree from Beth Israel School of Nursing and is a Kallah teacher. They have an open home and regularly host Friday night tisches, youth onegs, teen learning and much more. They have 6 children: Akiva (14), Naftali (12), Sruli (12), Daniel (10), Azi (6) and Miriam (3). Rabbi Leibtag and Ayelet are looking forward to meeting everyone in the Bnai Yeshurun family!

RABBI ZEV GOLDBERG

Rabbi Zev Goldberg is the Rabbi of the Young Israel of Fort Lee (YIFL), a position he has held since 2014. Under Rabbi Goldberg’s leadership, YIFL has grown by 50% and has blossomed into a welcoming and vibrant Torah institution, with abundant opportunities for learning and spiritual development. Prior to this position, Rabbi Goldberg was Assistant Rabbi of the Young Israel of Century City in Los Angeles (2010-2014), a leading West Coast shul of over 500 families.

Additionally, Rabbi Goldberg teaches a Professional Rabbinics class to Semikha students at Yeshiva University and serves as the Chair of the Torah Sh’Bal Peh Department at Bruria High School for Girls in Elizabeth, where he teaches Talmud and Halakha.

Rabbi Goldberg is the current Vice President of the Rabbinical Council of Bergen County (RCBC) and a Dayan on its Beit Din L’Geyur (conversion). He was a member of the Executive Board of the Rabbinical Council of America (RCA) from 2016-2019.

Rabbi Goldberg graduated with honors and received his Semikha from Yeshiva University. He is married to Dr. Michal Goldberg, a clinical psychologist and supervisor at Achieve Behavioral Health in Monsey, a private practice clinician in Teaneck and a Nishmat certified Kallah Teacher. The Goldbergs are the proud parents of Meira, Yakir, Elisha and Ayelet.

Rabbi Goldberg is a passionate teacher who believes in building community through Torah learning and personal relationships. He looks forward to meeting the members of Bnai Yeshurun.

Rabbi Zev and Leora Spitz, along with their children Esther (11), Yosef (10), Sarah (6) and Goldie (2), serve as the Associate Rabbi and Rebbetzin at Beth Avraham Yoseph of Toronto Congregation ("The BAYT"), a shul community of 800 families, in Toronto, Canada. They previously served as the Associate Rabbi and Rebbetzin at the Young Israel of Holliswood in Queens, NY.

Rabbi Spitz, from Hillcrest, NY, studied at Yeshivat Shaalvim in Israel. He graduated from Yeshiva University's Mazer Yeshiva Program and Sy Syms School of Business with a Bachelor of Science in Finance. Following six years in Real Estate Consulting and two years of study at Ner Israel Rabbinical College in Baltimore, Rabbi Spitz attended the Semicha Program of the Rabbi Isaac Elchanan Theological Seminary (RIETS) at Yeshiva University.

Rabbi Spitz has professional training from Project Chai: Crisis Intervention and Gottman: The Seven Principles of Marriage. He serves on the Executive Board of the Rabbinical Council of America.

Leora (Diament) Spitz, from Edison, NJ, received her Master's Degree in Speech and Language Pathology from The College of New Jersey. She previously worked as a speech and language pathologist for the New York City Department of Education.
