We would like to update you on the status of the CBY Rabbinic Search, especially for those who were unable to attend last week's Semi-Annual Generals Membership meeting.

At that meeting, the Rabbinic Search Committee ("RSC") updated the members on the search and how it has been matching up with the timeline set forth in the official Process approved by the Board, as well as outlining the remaining tasks and the timeline for their performance.

That presentation has now been uploaded to the shul's website where it can be viewed under the "Rabbinic Transition" tab (www.bnaiyeshurun.org/rabbinic-transition.html).

Please feel free to review that presentation at your convenience. Here, however, are some of the important highlights:

- The RSC has considered in excess of 50 candidates (55 to date).
- Of those candidates, 20 were applicants who officially submitted resumes (whether through the CJF or through direct application to the shul).
- The remaining candidates (35 to date) were a combination of *rabbanim* either recommended to us by third parties (primarily members of the shul) or who the RSC internally chose to pursue.
- Candidates included *rabbanim* from the US, Canada, England, Europe, and Israel.
- On December 14, after weeks of extensive research and review, the RSC reduced its list to 10 finalists, each of whom were invited to participate with the RSC in teleconference interviews. Those interviews have begun and are scheduled to run through December 25.

As a reminder of the work to come, following the completion of the teleconference interviews, the RSC will again reduce the list of finalists to approximately 6, each of whom will be invited to participate in face-to-face interviews with the RSC. Those are all
