We Meet Again!?

After the plague of darkness, Pharaoh reaches the point of his greatest frustration with Moshe, expelling him from his presence and declaring that he does not want to be seen by Moshe ever again. Moshe concurs, and says that indeed he will not see him again (10:28-29). This exchange seems to be the basis for Moshe's subsequent description of the consequences of the impending plague of the first-born: Then all of these servants of yours shall come down to me and bow to me saying, "Leave, you and all of the people who follow you..." Shemos 11:8)

Moshe prophesizes/predicts that Pharaoh will not come pleading to Moshe, because of his pledge not to see him again. Yet in fact when the plague descends upon the Egyptians, it seems that Pharaoh does come:

Pharaoh awoke at night, he and all of his servants and all of Egypt, and there was great wailing in Egypt... And he (Pharaoh) called for Moshe and Aaron that night and he said, "Arise and leave from amongst my nation, you as well as the People of Israel..." And Egypt pressured the people in order to hurriedly send them away from the land... (Shemos 12:30-33)

Is Pharaoh in violation of his original pledge? Was Moshe's prophesy /prediction inaccurate?

The Gift of Shabbos: The Source of our Sustenance

Imagine if every day, you woke up to a breakfast basket being placed right outside your door, with enough food for every member of your household. The food could taste like anything you wanted. It was light, nutritious, and delicious. Zero prep time, zero cleanup. Now imagine that the baskets aren't only arriving at your doorstep; they are being delivered to everyone you know.

One thought you may have is that whoever is sending these baskets must really like you. They must care about your family, your preferences, and your health. They must be fabulously wealthy to afford it. (Do you see where this is going?)

Shabbos recalls Yetzias Mizrayim, and by extension, the miracle of the Mann. And the connection runs deeper: Mann 'marked' the Shabbos each week, falling double on Friday and not at all on Shabbos. Each week, we begin our seuda with that double portion, two challahs, covered on top and bottom, just like the Mann was.

We remember Hashem's display of intimacy; we remember how He lovingly took care of us, day in and day out, for forty years in the desert. And as Shabbos comes to an end and we venture back out into the world, we remember that whether our parnassa comes delivered and giftwrapped to our doorstep or through a paycheck, both come directly from Hashem's loving and generous hand.
