PARSHA OUESTS

The Mishkan

The term "Mishkan" (25:9) is generally used in reference to the Tabernacle, the travelling Temple of the Jewish People in the desert. Yet we also find it specifically used (26:1) with regard to the innermost curtain that covered the Tabernacle. Why does the curtain have this distinction of being the "title object" of the entire Temple? Rashi points out that this curtain fit not only over the roof, but over the outside walls of the building as well, such that it can be seen as the building itself. Yet it is noteworthy that those standing outside the building would not see the Mishkan covering at all, because it was covered in turn by two more weather-resistant covers. Those standing inside would only see the ceiling covering, while the visible walls were the goldcovered beams. Why then do we give this curtain such prominence within the structure?

Note as well that when David declares his intention to build the Temple in Jerusalem, his motivation is expressed as follows (Shmuel II 7:2): "Behold I am sitting in a home built of cedarwood, while the Ark of G-d sits in a **curtain**."

The Gift of Shabbos - The Arc of History

Having discussed the twin aspects of Shabbos as queen, as extension of the King's honor, and bride, as a means of remolding our actions to reflect that honor, we can now ask: Why is it that each Shemoneh Esrei on Shabbos is different? We don't find that by weekdays, nor Yom Tov. So why Shabbos?

The Avudraham explains that there are three times in human history when Hashem reveals Himself for all the world to see, where He is universally recognized as the one Creator: (1) at the end of Creation, (2) at Har Sinai, and (3) in the times of Moshiach. Thus, our tefillos on Shabbos follow that arc.

We begin Friday night with *Atah Kidashta*—You sanctified the seventh day of Creation. This mirrors the "queen" aspect of Shabbos: we honor the King by declaring His Kingship over kiddush wine. On Shabbos morning, we say *Yismach Moshe*: Moshe rejoiced in the gift of Torah. This reflects the "bride" aspect: we conform our actions to the Torah's prescriptions, thus making Shabbos's presence tangible in the real world.

And after almost an entire day living in Hashem's world and by His dictates, our bodies and souls filled with Shabbos delights, we sit down to a small, intimate seuda with our Beloved, and daven for the era of Atah Echad: may all of Your children come to recognize You as the sole Source of their menucha.
