PARSHA QUESTS By Rabbi Moshe Hauer

The Red Heifer

The ritual of purification using the Red Heifer is the consummate "Chok" (humanly incomprehensible law of the Torah). The wisest of all men, King Shlomo, considered it beyond his understanding. The nations tease us that we blindly adhere to such seemingly senseless rituals (see TB Yoma 67b). It is an offering that is associated - at least by virtue of its red color - with Esau, the ruddy and bloody man known as "Edom" ("The Red One") [see extensively Ramban to Vayikra 16:8].

In light of this association it is noteworthv that the Talmud (Kiddushin 31a) records the story of a non-Jew who, because of his great care honoring his father, was rewarded with the birth of a rare and precious Red Heifer in his flock. We know of course that Esau (or Edom) also excelled in the honor he accorded his father. To further the association, this non-Jew's name was "Dama ben Nesina", the name "Dama" deriving from the term "Edom" or "Adom" meaning red, or "Dam" meaning blood-red.

What is the meaning of the association of this enigmatic *Mitzvah* with Esau? What is the meaning of its association with honoring parents? What is the meaning of the association of Esau and this other non -Jew with the ideal fulfillment of the *Mitzvah* of honoring parents?

The Gift of Shabbos – Mekor Habracha

Here's a trivia question: What do *aufrufs, shalom zachors,* and Shabbos Mevorchim all have in common? They all mark an important event in the coming week, and all will invariably involve someone, somehow, receiving a copy of *Building Eternity*.

The *minhag* of noting an event the Shabbos before is from an Ohr HaChaim on the pasuk from kiddush: ki sheishes yamim asah Hashem es hashomayim v'es ha'aretz—Hashem created the world in six days. However, the clause sheishes yamim in the above pasuk is missing a crucial prefix: the letter beis. Thus, the pasuk isn't saying that Hashem created the world besheishes yamim, in six days, but for six days. The world can only exist for six days at a time; what gives it the energy to be for another week is our observance of Shabbos. Hence, the power for a wedding derives from Shabbos, so we make an *aufruf*, and so on. Shabbos is, indeed, the mekor habracha for everything that follows.

What emerges is that the best way to ensure our success in the coming both personally week, and professionally, is to deliberately detach from the outside world-to immerse ourselves in all things Shabbos. To use this special time carefully and deliberately, and spend a few extra learning, moments davening, connecting with family and friends. It will be well worth our while.
