PARSHA OUESTS

For the Sake of Simcha

The Talmud (Niddah 31b) explains that the reason why the Torah scheduled the *Bris* for the eighth day after birth is to ensure that the seven day period of ritual impurity – *Tumah* - resulting from the birth of the boy concludes before the *Bris*. This upholds the *Simcha* of the *Bris*, allowing the husband and wife to rejoice together, unencumbered by the limitations imposed by the impure status.

Nevertheless, despite this concern of maintaining the joy of the Bris, we find that in practice the laws of impurity extend well beyond the eighth day. Because of a complex variety of concerns, Jewish women have adopted as binding custom to wait until all post-partum bleeding ceases, and to then count seven clean days before immersion in the Mikveh (see Yoreh Deah 194:1). Thus our adopted stringency contravenes the Torah's intent. Why is this appropriate? While we understand the Sages extending a prohibition beyond the Torah as a safeguard, in a case such as this where the Torah itself went "out of its way" to permit something, why is it appropriate for us to nevertheless forbid it?

The Gift of Shabbos – Visiting the Treasury

I have a confession to make. I've come to realize that if Shabbos is, in fact, the purpose of creation, then this column shouldn't be called the *gift* of Shabbos, which implies that we could live without it. I probably should have called it something else, like *Beis Hayayin v'Kiddush*. Or *Constructing Something That Lasts a Very Very Long Time*.

But I wasn't completely wrong. Hashem told Moshe, "I have a precious gift in my treasure houses, whose name is Shabbos, and I wish to bequeath it to Klal Yisrael. Go tell them of this." (Beitzah 16a) The Ohr Gedalyahu points out that Hashem does not tell Moshe to gift Shabbos to Klal Yisrael; He tells Moshe, rather, to tell them about Shabbos, that they may come into the treasury itself and enjoy Shabbos there. On Shabbos, we enter Hashem's inner sanctum, as it were; the gift of Shabbos is that we are allowed entry to this most sacred place.

And treasure is only precious when one realizes its value. More than gaining entry, Hashem's gift was in informing us just what Shabbos is: the chemdas hayamim, whose every moment is imbued with the Divine, whose essence is that of Olam Haba. We are enriched by our visit to the treasury to the extent that we appreciate just how special it is to spend this day with Hashem.


