Power of Attorney Form for Transaction of Chametz 5779

The Torah prohibits a Jew not only from consumption or benefit from chametz, or products containing chametz, but ownership as well (*bal yira'eh, bal yimatze*). One method of avoiding violating these prohibitions is to sell one's chametz prior to the outset of the holiday (*mechirat chametz*). The sale of chametz must be effectuated prior to the time point at which Chametz becomes prohibited for benefit on the 14th of Nissan 5779, April 19, 2019. For the sale to be effective at a legal (*halakhic*) level, the gentile to whom the chametz will be sold must have access to the chametz. As such, your cell phone, e-mail address, and the address at which the chametz will be kept must be recorded in this power of attorney document (*shtar harsha'ah*).

Power of Attorney

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Daniel Fridman to act in my place and stead and on my behalf to sell all chametz possessed by me knowingly or unknowingly, as defined by Torah and Rabbinic law, and to lease all places in which chametz owned by me may be found, especially at:
