

We look forward to sharing this simcha with family and friends as well as the Anshai Torah community.











CAT KIDS CLUB

It's Torah time, crafts, cooking, socializing and fun time, it's "getting to know you" for parents and Iil' ones from throughout Dallas' greater Jewish community as Congregation Anshai Torah introduces its Kids Club with programming for children six-months-old through second grade.

"Everyone who walks into Anshai becomes a part of our community and," said Rachel Blum, this year celebrating 10 years as CAT's director of education, "even at the youngest of ages - a part of the goodness we are."

"We're very excited to introduce these new programs for anyone in the Jewish community to participate in. Our doors are wide open, said Blum, who will lead the programs along with longtime and beloved CAT Preschool teachers Talia Maor and Rachel Steinberg. "We'll sing and dance, we'll create and celebrate and have our shul be home base, and a place for the next generation to want to be, is all we can give."

For children six months to three-years-old are invited to GrownUp & Me programs on Wednesday mornings from 10:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and on Fridays from 9:30 to 11 a.m. For those who are pre-K through second grade, programming is held from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m.

The GrownUp & Me Programs include engaging projects and playtime, storytime, science, art and physical activities. On Wednesdays, lunch is served and on Fridays there are Shabbat snacks and songs.

"It's about engaging our children and our parents, with one another, about building friendships that we imagine will last for years," said Blum.

Children from three-years-old through second grade are invited to register for CAT's Matzah Ball Family Shabbat and holiday programs with services, stories and songs, friendship-building and more. There will be a sukkah decorating party and a Pancakes in the Sukkah breakfast as well as themed Matzah Ball Family evenings with a menorah lighting, blessing of the animals and "fill in the ark" Shabbat services and dinner for the whole family.

The Wednesday afternoon programs, September 13, October 18, November 15 and December 13 includes Judaic crafts, holiday programming, cooking, an introduction to Hebrew language and dinner as well as inclusion for participants' immediate family members in holiday programs and Matzah Ball Family Shabbat services and dinners.

"We want to help our children and families build their Jewish identities and our children, and their grown-ups, are sure to be touched and, regardless of affiliation, to feel a part of the Anshai Family," said Blum.
