

Installing Zoom (Android)

Version 1.1

This document provides guidance for installing Zoom meeting software on an Android device so you can attend Judea Reform's Annual Meeting. **It is best if you do this well before trying to join the meeting so, if you have problems, you can get help.**

Installation

To install Zoom software, follow these steps:


1. Tap on the Google Play Store icon.
2. In the Google Play Store, tap on *Apps* at the bottom of your screen.
3. In the next screen, tap the search icon (the magnifying glass) at the top right.
4. Enter "Zoom" in the search text box.
5. The Play Store will show you a number of app choices. Tap on *ZOOM Cloud Meetings*.
6. In the next screen, tap *Install*.
7. In the next screen, tap *Accept*.
8. When the App Store has completed the installation, you will see the *Open* button. Tap it to launch Zoom.
9. Go back to the Home screen.

Testing


It's a good idea to have a test meeting to check out your speakers and microphone. This will also let you experiment with Zoom's user controls.

Follow these steps:


1. After installing Zoom, start the test meeting.
 - If you are reading this on-line, tap on <https://zoom.us/test>
 - If you are reading this on paper, enter <https://zoom.us/test> in your device's browser address line and tap the Enter key.
2. Your browser should open a window that looks something like this:




- Tap the Zoom icon so that it's highlighted, and then tap *Always*.
3. In the next window, tap *Got it* to permit Zoom to access your device's microphone, camera, and storage.




4. In the next window, tap *Deny* or *Allow* to permit or deny audio recording.



- Zoom will now show you a screen that looks something like this:



- Click the *Join* button. Zoom will ask you to enter your name. This name will appear on the screen during a meeting. It's usually a good idea to enter your real name. After you've entered your name, tap *Continue*.
- Zoom will now show a screen that looks like this, except it will display live video from your camera:



Click *Join with Video*.

- Zoom will start the meeting. You can experiment with the controls in that meeting to learn more about what Zoom enables you to do on a video call.
