

## Facilities Rental FAQ's

- **What amenities are included in the rental?** The rental fee includes tables and chairs, and for Rebecca K. Crown Social Hall dishware, flatware, and glassware as well.
- **Does the synagogue provide valet parking?** The synagogue does not provide valet parking, but you are free to hire a valet as long as they provide us with a certificate of insurance.
- **How long may our event last?** We are happy to work with you regarding the rental period.

In general

*For bar/bat mitzvah -*

the rental for an afternoon party is three hours, from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm, and the rental for an evening party is five hours, from 6:00 pm - 11:00 pm.

*For weddings -*

the rental for an afternoon ceremony and luncheon is 4 hours. For an evening ceremony and reception party, the rental is 6 hours. Start times are flexible and can be arranged with Jacki Sundheim, Lifecycle and Events Coordinator.

For all other events - rental times and duration are by arrangement with staff.

- **Can our wedding party get dressed at the synagogue?** Certainly! We have space for changing to accommodate the bridal party.
- **When can our décor contractor/caterer/florist begin set-up?** Normally, set-ups can begin 3-4 hours prior to the event, but might be earlier if arrangements are made with the staff.
- **What food can be served in the synagogue?** Generally, our synagogue is "kosher-style", meaning certain foods are not permitted (mostly pork, pork products, and shellfish) and meat and dairy are not overtly mixed. "Overtly mixed" means that meat and dairy are not included in the same recipe so as to enable a person to choose to keep foods separate. Kosher wine is not required.
