

# Getting to Leo Baeck for First Narayever Congregation Services

Leo Baeck Jewish Day School is located at 501 Arlington Ave., north of Vaughan Road, and right next to the Cedarvale Park. There are various ways of getting there, depending on where you live.

## **TTC:**

The Vaughan Rd 90 A which operates 7 days a week and can be taken from St. Clair W. subway station. Best to use [ttc.ca/trip\\_planner](http://ttc.ca/trip_planner) or one of many of the excellent apps available such as [Transit ▪ Bus & Train Times](#) which can give you advice about route planning, timing, and service alerts. The bus stop is at Vaughan Rd. and Arlington Ave.; just walk north to the school.

Walking from the Eglinton West subway station is direct and fairly short. Cross to the south side of Eglinton and walk west to Winnett Ave. Walk south on Winnett to Arlington Ave. and continue south to Leo Baeck. In the nice weather, you can take a paved path through Cedarvale Park, south from Ava Road just east of Winnett and you will see Leo Baeck Day School just beyond the tennis courts. There's another paved path to follow to the entrance to services.

**PLEASE NOTE:** In late March 2020, the bus loop at Eglinton West station will be closed for approximately five months for Crosstown LRT construction. Eglinton West station will remain open, but buses will not be able to access the station's bus loop.

## **Cycling:**

Cycling through Cedarvale Park and ravine is a very pleasant experience if you can do it. There is a row of ground level bike racks at the front of Leo Baeck School.

## **Walking:**

Check your favorite e-map for routes, Cedarvale Park is lovely and there are also very nice neighbourhoods to walk through.

## **Driving:**

Best to look at your favorite e-map for how to get there. Keep in mind that there are many one-way streets.

## **Parking:**

Like every other residential neighbourhood, parking is at a premium. There is limited parking behind Leo Baeck School (access from Dunham Ave.) and there is some street parking on Arlington and Winnett. But you may have to park a few streets away and walk to the school. **BE SURE TO OBEY ALL SIGNS REGARDING WHERE PARKING IS ALLOWED AND WHERE IT IS NOT.** We want to be good neighbours, please do not block driveways or park illegally.

There also is parking along the east side of Cedarvale Park. Strathearn Rd. around Markdale Ave. is a good choice and there is a walkway from there across the park to Leo Baeck.

You will see that Leo Baeck School is next to Phil White Arena. We are **NOT** allowed to park there on Shabbat. There have been some conflicts in the past over parking with synagogues who have rented space at Leo Baeck. Under the terms of our agreement with the school, we must honour the arrangements that have been made with the Arena. You may be tempted, but please don't park there.

There is also **NO** parking in the short driveway that runs parallel to Arlington Ave. at the south end of the building.

## **Sanctuary entrance:**

The entrance to the sanctuary is at the south end of the building, ground level. The main doors of the school facing Arlington Ave. will be locked. Signs will point you in the right direction.
