

## HIGH HOLIDAY TICKETS

Everyone requires a ticket for entrance into the services, including children who will be attending babysitting. Tickets for adult members are included with membership.

While children and teens to 19 years of age are included as members in their parent's membership, there is a fee for their High Holiday tickets.

Your adult children who are 20 to 29 years old are eligible to apply for and renew their own membership. Alternatively they can purchase a ticket as a non-member.

Adults who are 20 to 29 years of age are eligible for “**Young Adult Membership**”.

Full-time students who are 20 to 29 years of age are eligible for “**Student Membership**”.

You may also order extra tickets for guests.

The term “non-member” in the table below includes your guests and your adult children 20 to 29 years of age who have not taken out their own membership.
