

## **Guidelines While Attending Services at TRZ**

Masks must be properly worn, covering nose and mouth, at all times.

This will be enforced by our congregational greeters. If someone has to be asked 3 times to wear their mask properly and they do not comply, then they will be asked to leave. If they do not leave then the service will be stopped until they leave.

Everyone in attendance will have their temperature taken by a congregational greeter. Anyone with a temperature above 100.4 degrees will be told to go home.

If someone's temperature is above 100.4 degrees, then they can wait outside for 2 minutes and be rechecked. If the second reading is below 100.4 degrees they can be allowed to stay.

Physical distancing of at least 6 feet is required between each member or family pod.

Attendees should bring their own tallis and kippah.

Prayerbooks and Chumash will be placed and returned to book carts and only used for one service per week.

Bathrooms available on a single person user basis.

Water fountains are unavailable.

Singing with masks is allowed outdoors, but not recommended indoors.

Those who are leading services from behind the plexiglass shield can remove their masks. Congregants can participate in any parts of the service (excluding reading from the Torah scroll) from their seats or an alternative podium with their masks on.

As COVID-19 is not passed through contact with surfaces, per CDC guidelines, cleaning of surfaces will not take place between contacts. However, sanitizing stations will be available throughout the synagogue.

No Food or drink will be allowed in the building.

We discourage gathering either before or after services.

**Registration/Waiver**

I have not tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days.

I do not feel even slightly unwell (fever, coughing, shortness of breath, sore throat or sniffing).

I have not been exposed to someone who has COVID-19 or is a possible Covid-19 carrier, within the past 7 days.

I am not experiencing a loss of taste or smell.

By signing here, I acknowledge that I will abide by all the rules for attending services at Temple Ramat Zion and will abide by any instructions from the clergy and/or greeters regarding these rules.
