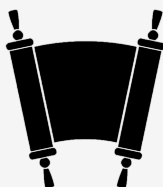

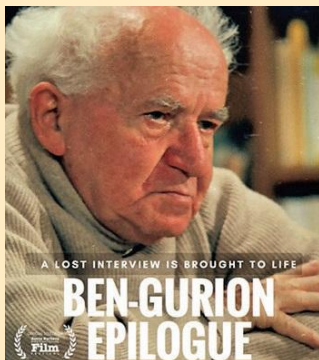

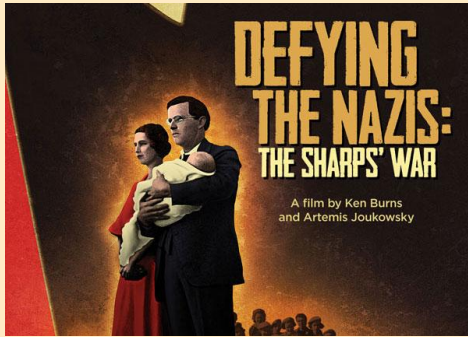

### Film Screening of *Defying the Nazis: the Sharps' War*

This 90 minute documentary directed by legendary filmmaker Ken Burns tells the story of Waitstill and Martha Sharp, an American minister and his wife from Wellesley, MA, who left their children behind in the care of their parish and boldly committed to a life-threatening mission in Europe. Over the course of two dangerous years they helped save scores of imperiled dissidents and refugees fleeing the Nazi occupation across Europe. Dozens of scientists, journalists, doctors, powerful anti-Nazi activists and children would find their way to freedom and start new lives in America because of their efforts and sacrifice.
