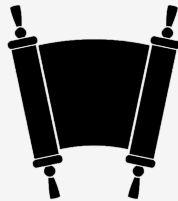

Community Update: TBZ's Search for Director of Congregational Learning

TBZ's Search Committee for our first-ever Director of Congregational Learning has been hard at work over the past months building a representative committee, crafting a job description, reaching out to our networks to post the position, vetting resumes, performing screening calls, and interviewing viable candidates. We have received well over a dozen applications from strongly qualified individuals and continue to accept and review new applicants. After reviewing each application carefully against our stated criteria, the committee did five video interviews, and plans to bring in two of these candidates for in-person interviews and visits during the month of March.
