Join us for our service led by Rav Claudia. Meet Rav Claudia and our lay leaders at the Kiddush following the service.



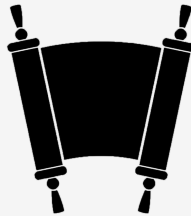
