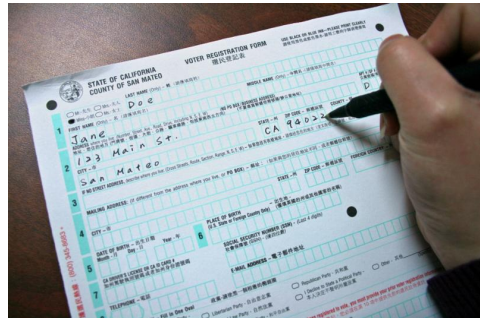


2018 Boston Jewish Food Conference:
