Clearly, the success of the Draw mirrors the gratitude the community has for the diverse ways that MTC touches lives – partially noted in the messages of our co-chairs and by Rabbi Itchy.

Thank G-d, our story is a reflection of a bigger picture, that of Chabad's ever broadening appeal world-wide.

The latest **Pew Report** on the state and trend of **US Jewry** is most revealing:

Whilst the Orthodox community continues to experience exponential growth, religious identification amongst the rest of American Jewry is in accelerated decline.

Bucking the trend is the startling percentage of American Jews who have engaged in some way with Chabad.

Here's the headline of an editorial written in response to the findings of the Pew Report by **Rabbi Efrem Goldberg**, senior rabbi of the popular Boca Raton Synagogue:

"Thirty eight percent of all US Jews have a connection with Chabad – the Rebbe passed away 27 years ago and his influence is greater than ever."

(Significantly, this number does not take into account the unquantifiable number of Jews inspired by Chabad's high-profile presence in the public arena both on the streets and in social media.)

What lies at the heart of the Chabad phenomenon?

Here are some salient quotes from Rabbi Goldberg's piece:

"At the core of the Rebbe's philosophy and worldview was his attitude that every Jew is a precious soul, a holy spark, with infinite potential and deserving of our love, loyalty, support and presence, wherever they may be. The Rebbe saw the good in all people. He believed in people. He empowered people to fulfil their mission on earth.

"The Rebbe was a great optimist who placed tremendous emphasis on the power of positive language and positive thinking. He insisted, for example, on referring to hospitals not as they are commonly referred to in Hebrew as 'Beit Cholim' — 'A Place for the III', but as a "Bet Refuah' — 'A Place of Healing'. Similarly he requested that injured soldiers not be referred to as 'disabled veterans' but as 'exceptional soldiers'.


Mark Strohl, CA of KPMG audited and oversaw the legalities of the draw.
