Dear friends,

As we enter into December, we are getting closer to our next holiday. Each year, after the High Holy Day season there is definitely that lull that takes us through the month of Cheshvan and most of the month of Kislev. As the days grow shorter and darker, though, we approach our Festival of Lights, the festival of Chanukah.

Chanukah is an amazing opportunity, during these dark days, to light up the world and light up our lives. We physically light the world, through the *mitzvah* of *pirsumei nisa*, literally the publicizing of the miracle, by lighting our *Chanukiyot* in the windows and showing the world the increasing number of lights on each night of the holiday.

And we have the opportunity to metaphorically light up our own lives as well, as we take the true meaning of Chanukah to heart. This holiday's name comes from the Hebrew word *חנוך* (chet. nun. kaf), which means "dedication." Chanukah allows us the opportunity to rededicate ourselves to our tradition and our community. We can come together for the first candle and our Chanukah party on December 18th to welcome in the festival together. We can, again, gather on the Shabbat of Chanukah (December 23rd) to light candles again as a community. And we can, each one of us as we are singing the blessings, be truly thankful for the miracle that occurred for our ancestors so many centuries ago and that we re-enact each year.

May the light of the Chanukah candles give light into each of our lives and may it be a festival filled with joy.

Shalom chaverim - Hello my friends!

I hope you and your loved ones are doing well. Well...it is that time of year! Chanukah! Oh - the *Chanukiyot*, *Sufganiyot*, *Latkes*, *Dreidels*, *Gelt*, and, of course - presents! There are so many wonderful things about Chanukah. I think this year, this holiday of our religious freedom rings true in light of the rising acts of antisemitism we have experienced in our country, as well as those experienced by our world wide Jewish community. It is tradition to place the lighted *Chanukiah* in a street-facing window for all to see. When my wife and I moved into our neighborhood, I was a little nervous following this tradition. I was waiting for something to happen - a neighbor that used to say "hi" stop doing so, or maybe an anonymous letter in my mailbox calling me a dirty Jew. These things happened to my family when I was growing up. But it never caused us to hide that we were Jewish. And so, every year we put our lighted *Chanukiah* so that it can be seen from the street. Because during the darkest days of the year, a little light is always needed. Because hiding, maybe even extinguishing, our light (s) is exactly the goal of antisemitism, we must do the opposite.


May your *Chanukah* shine every so brightly!






Our Mission: The Women of Congregation Dor Tamid's primary function is to support the synagogue through Judaism, Community Service, Friendship & Fundraising.


