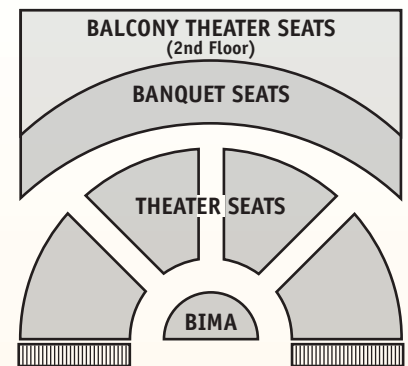

IMPORTANT REMINDERS: Members must be current with previous year's commitment before making a pledge for 2018-2019. Please complete and detach the 2018-2019 Congregational Commitment/High Holy Day Seating and Service Preference form (and any other applicable forms) and **return to Temple Israel** in the enclosed envelope. We must receive your completed commitment form by **June 30, 2018**.

SEATING INFORMATION

- Tickets are required for **all** services, including our family services.
- If you would like to request the same seats you had last year, please indicate this on the Seating and Service Preference Form. We must receive your commitment form by **June 30, 2018** to guarantee your preference. **Seats are assigned on a first come, first served basis, in the order that commitment forms are received.**
- Children's seats are only for dependent children whose permanent address is your home.

PARKING INFORMATION

- All donor levels include a parking pass. Once donor and handicapped passes are distributed, additional parking passes will be issued based on availability and date of commitment form receipt. If you will require handicapped parking, please indicate this on the Congregational Commitment and Payment Form and submit the necessary documentation by **June 30, 2018**. **We are not able to issue handicapped parking passes without a copy of your current state issued parking placard.**

SERVICE INFORMATION

- Temple Israel's Schedule of Services and Youth Programs will be sent out electronically and made available on Temple Israel's website by August 1, 2018.
- Youth programming and babysitting are only available to Temple members.

TEMPLE ISRAEL RELIGIOUS SCHOOL (TIRS) INFORMATION

- If you plan to register for TIRS, your 2018-2019 registration is not complete until we have received your Temple commitment form, TIRS registration form, and the 25% TIRS registration deposit. In addition, you must be current on all tuition payments.

BUILDING FUND INFORMATION

- When you join Temple Israel, you make a commitment to our Building Fund. Payments begin after your first year of membership. This commitment (\$500 young adults, ages 21-34 or \$1,000 adults, age 35+) is billed over a five-year period for your convenience, and appears on your December 1 invoice.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION
