

JRC B'NAI MITZVAH KIDDUSH INSTRUCTIONS

For approximately 150 guests

For the Bimah (during the service)

- 1 small challah, unsliced
- *JRC will provide challah tray, cover and Kiddush cup with juice/wine*

For the Kiddush (after the service)

- Grape Juice – 2-3 large bottles
- Challah – 2-3 large loaves, cut in bite-size squares
- Small Plastic Cups (approx. 2.5 oz.)
- Napkins
- **Optional:** cookies, doilies, plant/flowers for decoration

For a standard Kiddush in the Lobby, JRC Provides

- 2 Long Tables
- Table linens
- Trays/Baskets/Pitchers

You Provide

- Dishes/Glassware/Silverware
- Paper Goods (including Cups)
- Coffee/Tea/Sugar/Cream
- Challah/Juice/Wine

Please Note

- ***Absolutely no glitter is to be used***

Instructions for Kiddush Set-Up

- The JRC Custodian will set up tables in the lobby and clean the space after the kiddush – everything else is the family's responsibility
- Appoint at least 2 people to set-up Kiddush; these can be family/friends or hired help
- Trays, baskets and pitchers are available in the kitchen
- Plan on 30-45 minutes set-up time (depending on number of guests)
