From the desk of Eliot Tillinger... Religious School Director

As we approach the close of this school year, we reflect back on our classroom lessons and enriched activities. From our youngest students in the primary grades, to our upper students in the intermediate grades, our children have accomplished learning about our Jewish heritage, holiday customs and being a member of a tightly connected community, locally and in the greater world today.

Today's families are increasingly finding the time demands of work, school and extracurricular activities competing for each other's attention. Among the many choices parents make, one thing is certain, the obligation and desire to provide our children with an education is a universal goal. Our religious school faculty take these facts to heart; they believe in the holy mission to educate their students and enrich their understanding of Judaism as well being an active participant of our synagogue community. Our religious school classrooms are now 100% equipped with the latest computer technology, which has notably enhanced the students' experiences. From our internet research accessibility, to our live real-time interactive classroom sessions with schools in Israel, our lessons are a shining example of cutting-edge technology integration.

Parents are always welcome to accompany their children into Junior Congregation and then into the main sanctuary service, immediately following the Junior Congregation service.

The saying, "the more you put into something, the more you get out of it," applies here as well. Bringing children to school on time, attending class sessions regularly, and participating in our religious school extracurricular events, ensures the greatest degree of success.

Our upcoming school year planning has already begun and we are anticipating additional off campus field trips to further enrich our students' experiences and learning. Additional suggestions and ideas are always welcome and appreciated; feel free to stop by and share your past experiences with our faculty and staff.

Certainly among the most rewarding thing to see, is our children proudly displaying their knowledge with beaming pride. Classrooms in our religious school provide much more than a Jewish education, bonds of friendships forged, camaraderie, and connection to each other as Jews.
