

Are you listening? Every month the religious school focuses on a different prayer and value, this past month we have been talking about the meaning of the Shema, which coupled nicely with the value of the month, Shmiat HaOzen. Shmiat HaOzen means being attentive and a good listener. Students have been practicing listening through exercises that will hopefully be practiced at home.

Another large shift has been working on Hebrew in smaller groups. This has been led by both teens and staff, and give students an opportunity to practice and grow their reading and tefillah skills.

The first half of every teen Hebrew High session students examine the weekly Torah portion. Recently one of those discussions included Abraham negotiating for the lives of the righteous people of Sodom. The teens spoke about how Abraham influenced God and Lot. 


