From the desk of Liz Singer... Director of Life Long Learning

B'nai Aviv Religious School had their first week of classes and everything went fabulously. The preparation and implementation of the days' success hinged on the dedicated staff. To begin the year the teacher met for three hours on August 19th. At this training the expectations of the school year were discussed, as well as introducing new ways to supplement curriculum, and how to interject different learning activities into the school day.

As part of these efforts art has been installed in the school hallways. These pieces reflect different concepts and thinkers from our history. Yes it makes the walls more visually appealing, but it also serves as yet another entry point for students to reflect on. Teachers have prompts and questions to for each poster aid in provoking the students' observations.

The goal is to have learning experiences available to our students around every corner. This can be done labeling classroom objects in Hebrew, teaching students how to order snacks in Hebrew, asking about their week during the opening rituals and relating this to our value of the month (September is Chanassat Orchim- Welcoming the Stranger). The value curriculum will be paralleled through the service opportunities that will be provided through the Kehillah Club.

The Kehillah Club is a social action organization for families with children in 3rd-7th Grade. Monthly programs will include a little bit of learning and a lot of work with various area organizations to better our community. Applications for Kehillah Club can be requested from the religious school office, and are due back by September 30th. Participating families will be notified and the first program will take place in late October.
