GENERAL INFO

CAMP SEASON JUNE 17 - AUGUST 9

Campers may enroll for any number of weeks all summer. Last minute changes to the schedule may occur without notice due to weather conditions. This includes field trips and on-campus activities.

LUNCHES/SNACKS: Pareve or dairy lunch may be brought to camp each day. NO MEAT will be allowed at camp as we are a kosher facility. We are also a nut-free facility - no products containing nuts may be brought to camp. Camp Koach provides snacks and drinks each day. You may purchase lunch daily, weekly, or monthly and are available for purchase 5 days/week. Submit your lunch order at least one-week in advance.

INSURANCE The cost of liability insurance is included in your camp fee. Campers must maintain their own medical insurance for primary coverage.

CAMP T-SHIRTS Each camper will be provided with one complimentary camp T-shirt. Campers in Kindergarten and older - camp shirts must be worn whenever we leave the B'nai Aviv campus. Junior Division campers (ages 16 months-Pre-K) should wear their camp shirts on Fridays. Extra shirts can be purchased for \$15 each. Extra camp T-shirts must be ordered by May 10.

POLICY & HEALTH FORMS All health, vaccination and policy forms MUST be handed in to the camp office by May 24 or your child will not be permitted to attend camp.

JUNIOR DIVISION • 16 months - Pre-K

Our senior staff members are professionals experienced in early childhood. Activities are based on weekly themes and will include a variety of hands-on experiences such as water and sand play, music, story time, cooking, arts & crafts and weekly Shabbat. In addition to our weekly themes, we will be incorporating many special activities including character visits, a petting zoo, bounce houses, and more within our secure campus.

SENIOR DIVISION BOYS • Grades K-3

Senior campers take part in sports, karate, cooking, and more. They also attend field trips to various locations around South Florida, such as Paradise Cove, Bowling, and Off the Wall multiple times per week. On Fridays, campers will participate in a Shabbat program. They will also take part in various shows and special activities geared to their age group, as well as compete in a Color War. They will travel two days per week for our swimming program (certified lifeguards on staff.*)

B'NAI GIRLS • Grades K-3

Not all girls enjoy archery, basketball and other traditional day camp activities. Some girls just "wanna have fun!" and that doesn't always include sports or getting dirty. At B'nai Girls, your child will develop their creativity, build independence and self-reliance, learn new skills, and gain confidence. Young ladies receive a well-rounded camp experience that includes dancing, cheerleading, drama, music, gymnastics, cooking karaoke, karate, jewelry design, field trips and more. Campers will also participate in camp activities and special events. Trips include a Spa Day, Sip & Sparkle, C by Me, Board & Brush, and Museums. Swim two days per week.*

REGISTRATION POLICIES:

- Applications must be submitted to the B'nai Aviv office. A \$50 non-refundable (registration fee) and a \$100 non-refundable deposit
 (applied to the tuition) per child required. Checks, credit cards, and cash are accepted.
- You must specify the exact weeks enrolled by April 16, 2024.
- Full payment is due by May 28, 2024. Register on or after June 1, 2024, and full payment is due at time of registration.
- If a camper withdraws from camp, written notice must be given to Camp Directors.
- No refunds or credits after May 28, 2024. No refunds due to absenteeism or for any other reason.
- If child/ren are picked up late you will be charged \$10 per child for every 10 minutes over the pick up time.
