CAMP SEASON JUNE 12TH through AUGUST 4TH. Campers may enroll for any number of weeks all summer.

LUNCHES/SNACKS A pareve or dairy lunch may be brought to camp each day. NO MEAT will be allowed at camp as we are a kosher facility. In addition, we are a nut-free facility and therefore no products which have nuts in them may be brought to camp. Camp Koach will provide snacks and drinks each day. You may purchase lunch daily, weekly, or monthly. Lunches will be available for purchase 5 days per week. Submit your lunch order at least one week in advance.

INSURANCE The cost of liability insurance is included in your camp fee. Campers must maintain their own medical insurance for primary coverage.

CAMP T-SHIRTS Each camper will be provided with one complimentary camp T-shirt. For campers in Kindergarten and older, camp shirts must be worn whenever we leave the B'nai Aviv campus. Junior Division campers should wear their camp shirts on Fridays. Extra shirts can be purchased for \$15.00 each. Extra camp T-shirts must be ordered by May 10th online or from the Camp Office.

POLICY & HEALTH FORMS In order for your child to attend camp on the first day, all health, vaccination and policy forms in the parent packet must be handed in to the camp office by May 28th. Please note that last minute changes to the schedule may occur without notice due to weather or covid-19 pandemic conditions. This includes field trips and on-campus activities.

B'ngi Aviv is excited to offer a High Achieving Special Needs Camp this year!

Developmental disabilities include High achieving Autism Spectrum Disorder, Controlled ADHD, cognitive delays, moderate speech and/or sensory processing issues.

With strategic programming specially designed for individuals with special needs, our community's camp will provide meaningful and engaging experiences that support healthy lifestyles – physically, socially, and emotionally. Through Jewish summer camp those with special needs are made to feel that they have a place and a voice in our community and that they truly belong.

All campers must do an intake with the Director. Limited space is available. Small group ratios with specialized camp counselors.

JUNIOR DIVISION 16M-PRE-K

Our senior staff members are professionals experienced in early childhood. Activities are based on weekly themes and will include a variety of hands-on experiences such as water and sand play, music, story time, cooking, arts & crafts and weekly Shabbat. In addition to our weekly themes, we will be incorporating many special activities including character visits, a petting zoo, bounce houses, and more within our secure campus.

SENIOR DIVISION K-5TH GRADES

Senior campers will take part in sports, karate, cooking, and more. They will also attend field trips to various locations around South Florida, such as Paradise Cove, Bowling, Off the Wall, and much more multiple times per week. On Fridays, the campers will participate in a Shabbat program. They will also take part in various shows and special activities geared to their age group, as well as compete in a Color War. In addition, they will be traveling two days per week for our swimming program staffed with certified lifeguards.*

B'NAI GIRLS K-5TH GRADES

B'nai Girls is our camp for girls, ages 6 -10. Not all girls enjoy archery, basketball and all the other traditional day camp activities. Some girls just "wanna have fun" ... and their idea of fun does not always include sports, nature, or getting dirty.

At B'nai Girls, your child will develop their creative abilities, build independence and self-reliance, learn new skills, and gain confidence. Our young ladies receive a well-rounded camp experience that includes dancing, cheerleading, drama, music, gymnastics, cooking karaoke, karate, jewelry design, field trips and more.

Campers will also participate in camp activities and special events. Field trips include a Spa Day, Sip and Sparkle, C by Me, Board and Brush, Museums and more. They will also swim two days per week.*

TEEN TRAVEL DIVISION 4TH - 8TH GRADES

Registration Policies

- ▶ Application and registration may be completed online. Completed paper applications must be submitted to the B'nai Aviv office. A \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee and a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit per child required (applied to the tuition) to enroll campers. Credit cards are accepted online only and will incur a service fee. Only checks or cash are accepted with the paper application form.
- ► You must specify the exact weeks enrolled by April 16, 2023.
- ► Full payment is due by May 28, 2023. Register on or after June 1, 2023, and full payment is due at time of registration.
- ▶ If a camper withdraws from camp, written notice must be given to the Camp Directors.
- ▶ No refunds or credits after May 28, 2023. No refunds due to absenteeism or for any other reason.
- ▶ If child/ren are picked up late you will be charged \$8.00 per child for every 10 minutes over the pick up time.

Early Bird Discount & Specials—

- ► You must specify the amount of weeks when registering in order to qualify for the early-bird discount.
- ► Take 3% off each additional sibling registered for summer camps. Minimum of 4 weeks.
- ► Refer a NEW Family's Camper and receive an additional 3% off your camp tuition for one child. Minimum of 4 weeks.
