

HIGH HOLIDAYS HONORS GUIDE

Your honors card indicates the approximate time of your honor. Your card also indicates the page number on which your honor will occur, so that as the service progresses you can gauge how soon your name will be called. Ten minutes prior to your appointed time, please move to the front of the sanctuary to the Honors section at the front of the sanctuary, to the left of the *bimah*.

Please note that when going up onto the *bimah*, men are expected to wear *kippot* and women are expected to wear a head covering. Jewish men are also expected to wear a *tallit*.

When you are called to the *bimah* for your reading, you may read directly from the enclosed copy, or from the *Machzor* that will be provided to you, as you prefer.
