Additional Tickets

These are available for additional immediate family members or guests who would like to attend services on High Holy Day services at Temple Kol Emeth. Tickets for adults over the age of 25 are \$195 per person. This price includes admission for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur services. College students and active military receive complimentary admission with a valid ID. For ages 18 and under, there is no charge.

Memorial Plaques

If you would like to order a plaque to memorialize your loved one in our sanctuary, please complete and return the appropriate form on the website above. Orders must be in prior July 10 in order to be guaranteed for the High Holy Days.

Babysitting

This is available for children ages 2 through 4 years old; forms can be downloaded from the website above. (Fees apply). **Early registration, for discounted fees, must be received by TKE no later than Friday, August 17. Only children who are registered by Friday, August 24, will be admitted in order to ensure accommodations for all.**

High Holy Day Youth Programming

We have a fantastic High Holy Day Youth program scheduled for grades K - 4 and 8 - 12. Our interactive program will help children of all ages to embrace the High Holy Days in a fun and educational environment. Children enrolled in most groups will rotate through classrooms filled with activities ranging from mitzvah projects, prayer and worship, and other Jewish educational experiences. For grades 5-7, we encourage your children to attend regular services with you to prepare them for their upcoming b'nai mitzvah. Registration for this program will be forthcoming in mid-August.
