Below is a summary of the High Holy Day forms available on the TKE website:

#### **Tickets**

Tickets are available to those who would like to attend High Holy Day services at Temple Kol Emeth. Tickets for adults over the age of 18 are \$195 per person. This price includes admission for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur Services. College students and active military will receive complimentary admission with a valid ID.

#### **Memorial Plaques**

If you would like to order a plaque to memorialize your loved one in our sanctuary, please complete and return the appropriate form on the website above IMMEDIATELY. We must receive completed forms by July 10 in order to guarantee delivery by the High Holy Days.

#### **Babysitting**

This is available for children ages 2 through 4 years old; forms can be downloaded from the website above. (Fees apply). **Early registration (for discounted fees) must be received by TKE no later than FRIDAY AUG. 17, 2018. ONLY CHILDREN WHO ARE REGISTERED BY FRIDAY, AUG. 24, 2018, WILL BE ADMITTED.**

#### **High Holy Day Youth Programming**

We have fantastic High Holy Day Youth programs for grades **K - 4 and 8 - 12**. (Note: grades 5 - 7 attend adult services). Our interactive program will help children of all ages to embrace the High Holy Days in a fun and educational environment. Children enrolled in most groups will rotate through classrooms filled with activities ranging from mitzvah projects, prayer and worship, and other Jewish educational experiences
