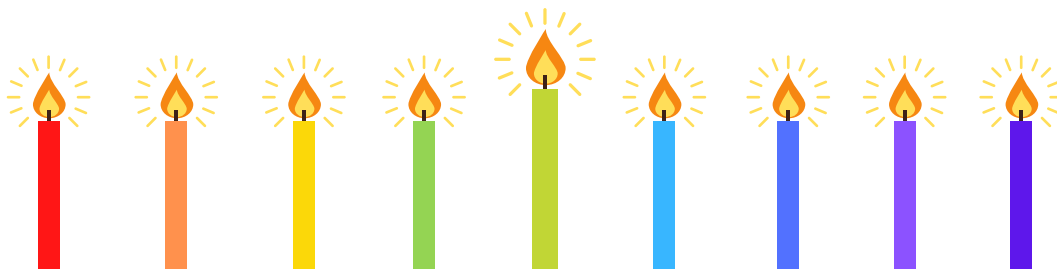


Chanukah begins at sundown on Thursday, December 10, 2020

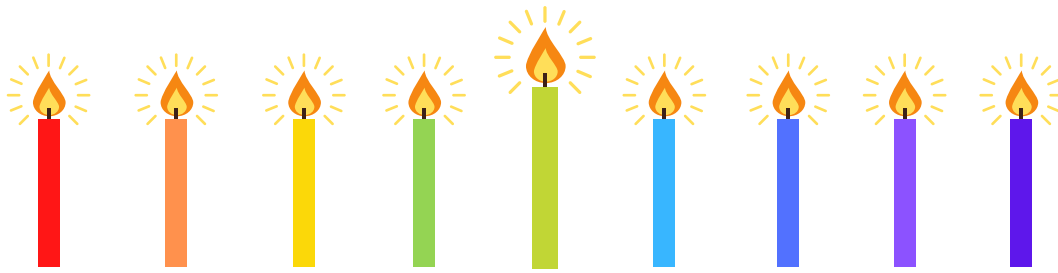

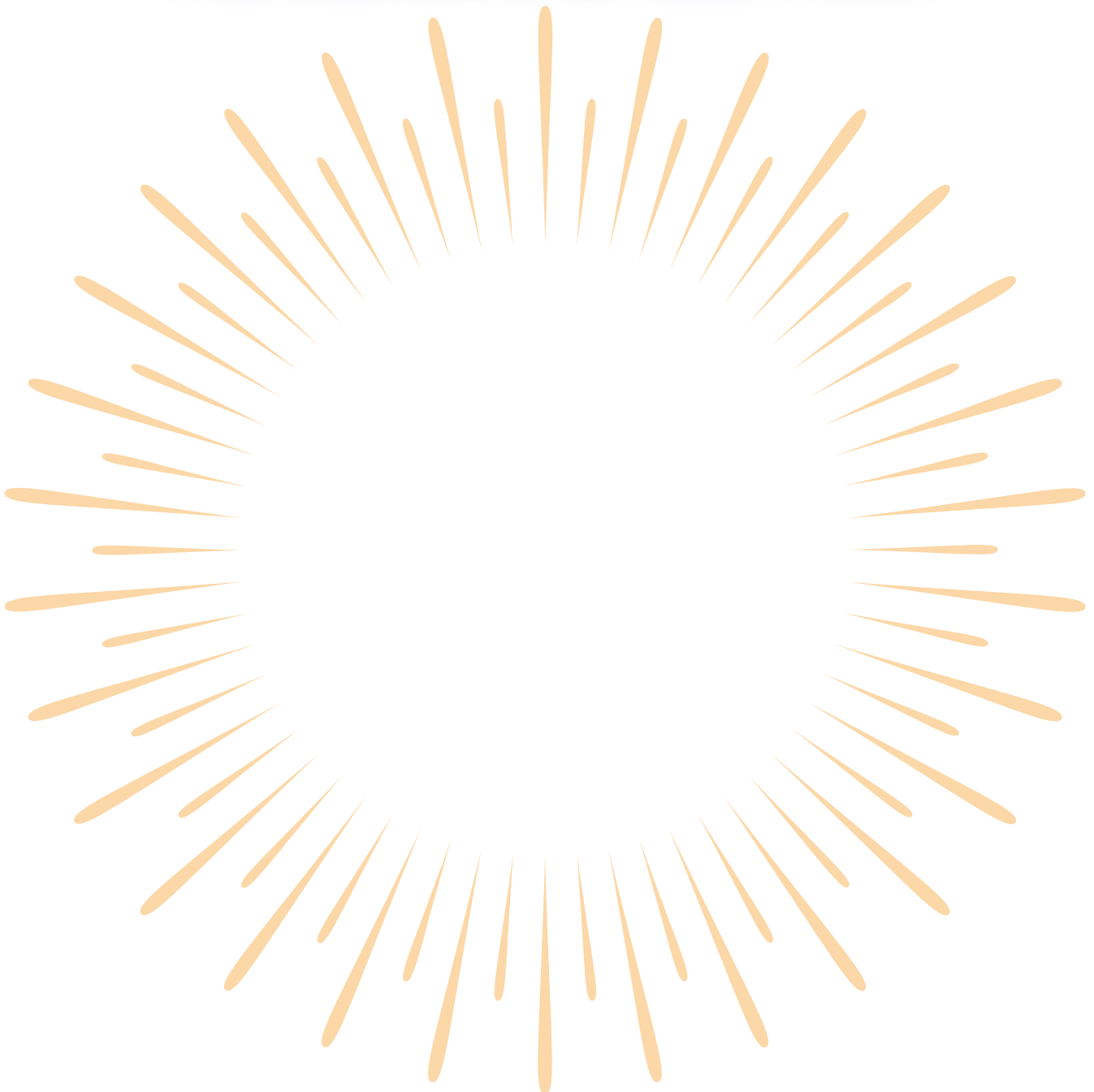
