Hope grew up in Orlando, FL, and spent eight summers on staff at Camp Coleman where she currently serves as a member of the camp committee.

Hope was a collegiate athlete, receiving scholarships for basketball, soccer and cross-country at Webber International University where she earned a B.S. in Business Administration with a concentration in Management and Marketing. She formalized her academic training earning an M.A. degree in Religious Education at Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, and the title Reform Jewish Educator (RJE).
