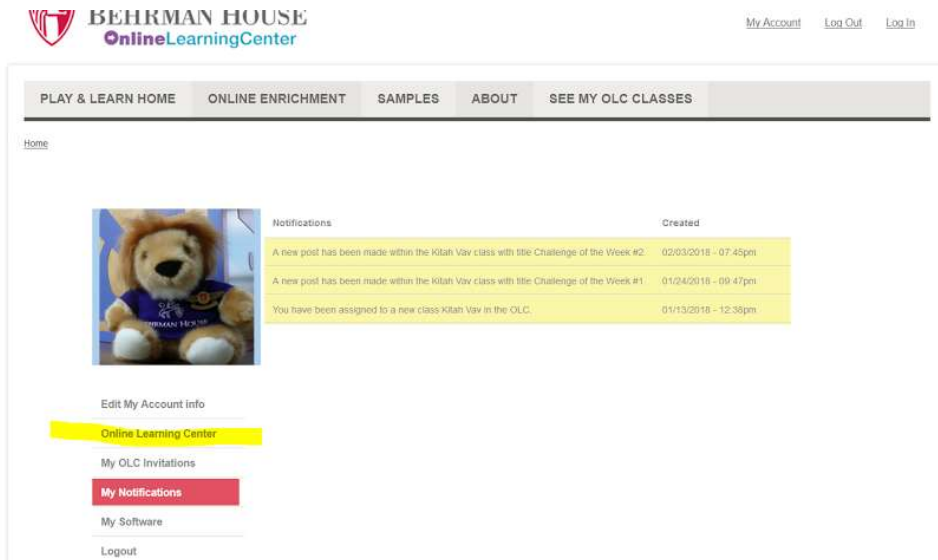


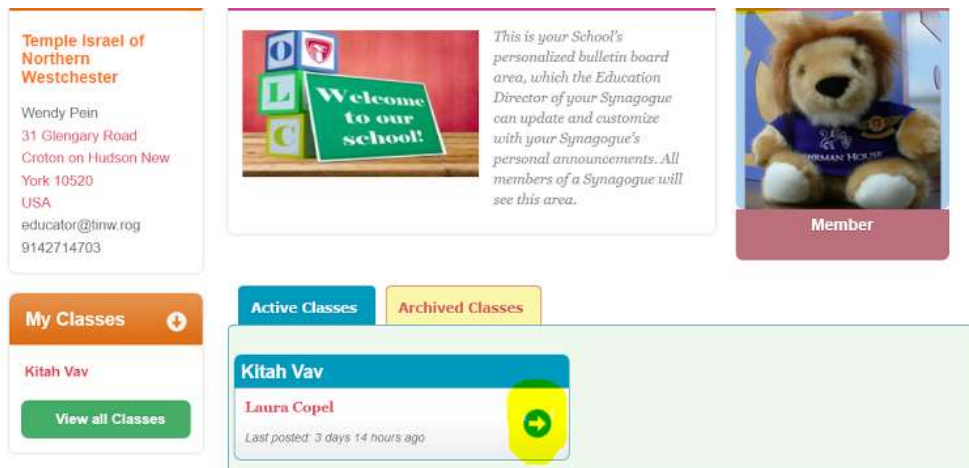
If you've logged in before, skip to the bottom of page 2.

Next you will see a screen that looks like this where I've highlighted the link you must click to go to the Online Learning Center.

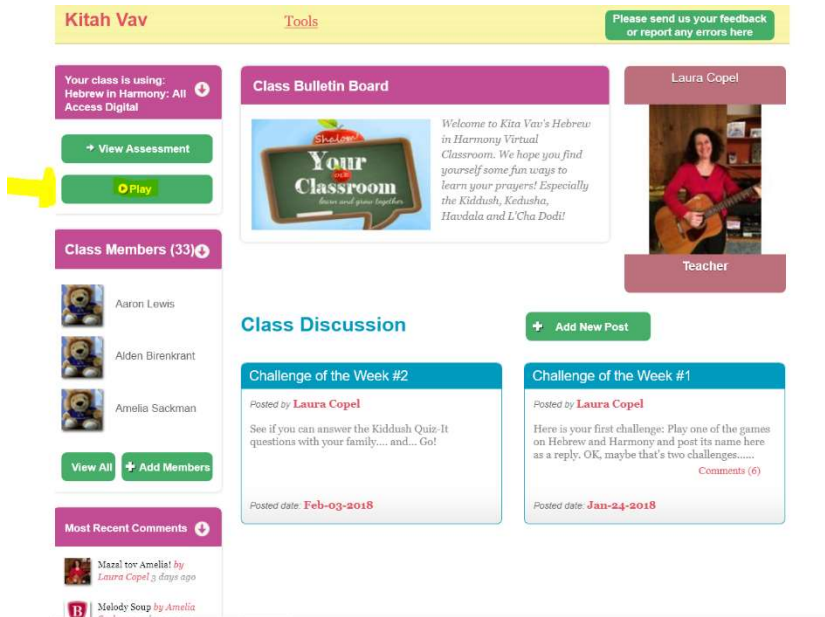


After you click the 'Online Learning Center' you'll see a screen where I've highlighted the arrow to click to enter the class. As teacher, my options are a little different.

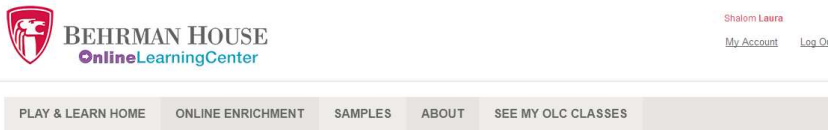


Once you've entered the class, you'll see this screen where I've highlighted the Hebrew in Harmony button on the left. Click on the green Play button:

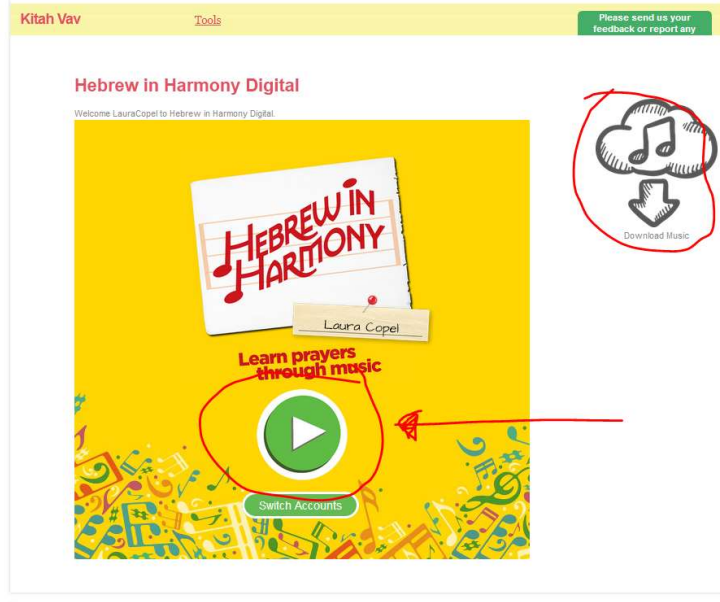

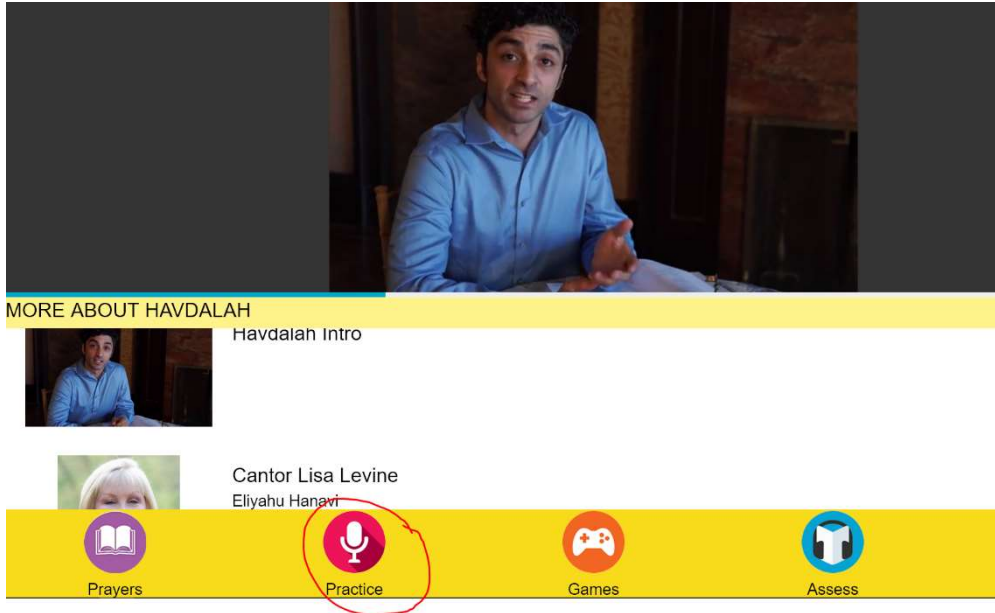


Once you've hit the play button, you will get a list of prayers to choose.

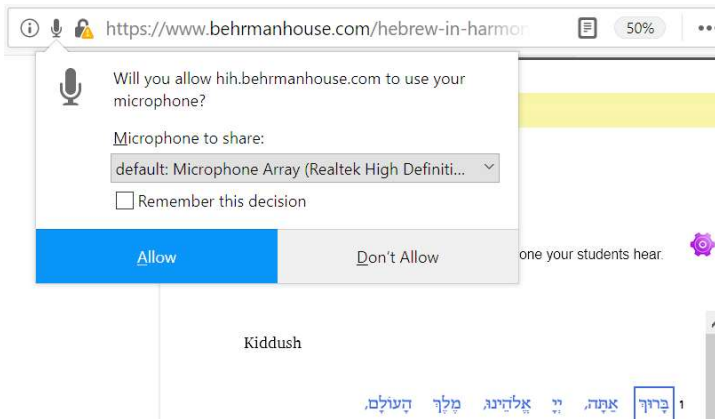
For the current lesson, please scroll down and choose Havdalah, highlighted in the screen below.

Once you've chosen Havdalah, you'll see the home screen for Havdalah - the introductory video starts automatically. There are lots of options to choose.

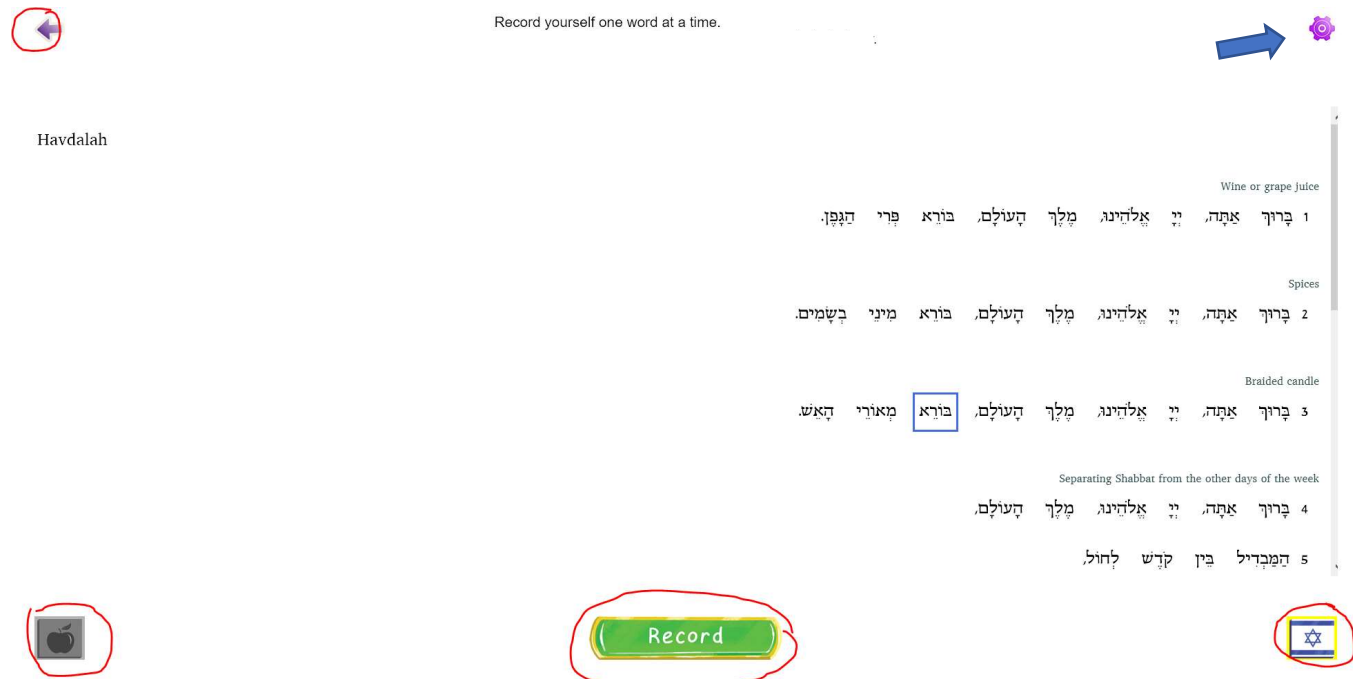


For recording, press the Practice option I circled in red. It looks like a microphone.

Once you've clicked Practice, you may be prompted for Hebrew in Harmony to get access to your device's microphone. Press Allow!



Once you've given permission for microphone access, you will see a screen like the one below.



Press any word and hear the correct pronunciation. If you click the apple you will hear my voice. If you press the Israeli flag, you will hear the word spoken with an Israeli accent. You can use either one as the model for your recording. Use this screen to practice reading the words. Press the word to determine if you were correct.

You can use the purple gear icon in the upper right corner to choose whether to practice/record word by word, line by line or the whole prayer - if you dare!

When you are ready to make a recording for me, click on a word or line, depending on your gear setting. Listen to it. Then press the green **Record** key and HOLD IT! Speak the word clearly into your device's microphone and then release the record key. Do not release the key until you have finished the word or line.

Repeat the recording process with as many words/lines as you feel comfortable. It doesn't have to be in order. And you can re-record any word or line.

Play back your own recording to be sure it sounds the way you expected. Do not exit the program until you can hear your own voice for all the words/lines you recorded.
