The Selling of the Chametz

The Torah (Exodus 12:19) commands throughout the Festival of Pesach, "Leaven may not be found in your houses, for anyone who eats anything which is leavened (*Chametz*) – that soul shall be cut off from the assembly of Israel."

In fact, Scripture states this injunction prohibiting *Chametz* in our homes during Pesach no less than three times. The Rabbis interpret this trifold Mitzvah as not only prohibiting the eating of leavened products, but to command we Jews not to see, own, or benefit from any leavening or leavened product during Passover.

Of course, the task of ridding ourselves totally of all products made of grain (with the exception of eighteen-minute *matzah*) often proves difficult to accomplish. What about those half eaten-boxes of Cheerios or the box of pasta we just couldn't finish in time?

Our Sages devised a brilliant solution. They decided one must gather all of this half-eaten Chametz to an unseen place, and then sell it (the *Chametz* and the place) to a non-Jew for the duration of the Pesach holiday.
