

Outline from A Family Haggadah II

- p.6 Blessing for candles; *Shehecheyanu* blessing on the first night (read in Hebrew and also in English if you'd like)
- p.8 (optional) review the order ("*Seder*") of the *Seder*; sing order if desired
- p.10 Blessing for 1st cup of wine (omit section for Shabbat in parenthesis/brackets during year 2020). You can continue with full *Kiddush* on following page or just to the briefer blessing on p.10; be sure to do *Shehecheyanu* blessing on bottom of p.12
- p.14 First handwashing (no blessing).
This is a great place to include the materials for Miriam's cup in the supplement of materials celebrating women
- p.14 *Karpas* (We dip a Vegetable); blessing for *Karpas*
(Optional: Sing Dodi Li on p. 15)
- p.16 Break the Middle *Matzah* – read in English and break the middle *Matzah*. Sing *Ha Lachma Anya* if you know it and want to
- p.18 The 4 questions (Sing in Hebrew; read in English afterward)
- p.20 Read in English; sing *Avadim Hayinu* in Hebrew if you wish
- p.22 The Four Children (read in English)
- p.24 & 26 Read the Passover Story
- p.28 The 10 plagues; read in English and read the list of plagues in Hebrew and/or English. Spill a drop from your cup of wine for each plague with a spoon or your finger into a plate or napkin
- p.30 Read in English; sing *V'hi SheAmdah* in Hebrew if you wish
- p.32 *Dayeinu*. Sing in Hebrew and read in English
- p.34 Read in English to explain the key *Seder* symbols. This is also a great place to explain the rest of the seder symbols on the table if you'd like to!
- p.36 Read in English (and Hebrew if you'd like) "In Every Generation" (this is one of the key phrases of the *Seder*!), and (optional) "Songs of Praise" in Hebrew and/or English
- p.38 (Optional) Sing *B'tzeit Yisraeil* in Hebrew; transliteration is on the following page
Blessing for the 2nd cup of wine
- p.40 Handwashing (with Blessing)
Blessings for *Motzi* & *Matzah* (do both blessings before eating *Matzah*; the first is for bread generally and the second is for *Matzah* specifically)

p.42 Blessing for bitter herb (*Maror*)

Hillel Sandwich (make and eat a sandwich out of *Matzah, Charoset & Maror*)

THEN WE EAT THE FESTIVE MEAL!

p.44 Find & eat the *Afikoman* (this is a good time to serve & eat dessert); you can read the English here or you don't have to.

Blessing after the meal (in Hebrew or English; or share what you are grateful for!)

p.48 Blessing for the 3rd cup of wine

Open the door for Elijah; sing *Eliyahu Hanavi*

p.50-59 Songs of praise; traditional seder songs.

This is also a great time to include song parodies and such from the Seder supplements!

p.60 The 4th (& Final) Cup of wine; Say the blessing. Read in English, "Our seder is now..."

Sing *L'shana Habaah B'Yerushalayim* -Next year in Jerusalem!
