

KHN Policy

Title: Borrowing KHN Property Policy

First Reading 21 September 2016

Purpose:

This policy defines how KHN property may be borrowed by members and non-members for events and activities that do not occur at KHN. If the off-site event is a KHN event this policy does not apply. A KHN event includes services, holiday celebrations, shul school classes and activities, KHN directed education events, KHN board or committee meetings, KHN-led fund raisers, and KHN community celebrations.

Use:

All KHN property, including books, tables, chairs, kitchen items, shul school items, linens, religious items, and torah cannot be borrowed. Specific exceptions for members include library books, which can be checked out, books for Shiva services for members or member's families, yarmulkes for use at Shiva services and, if needed, folding chairs for Shiva services. Other exceptions can be made with approval of the rabbi and KHN president.
