

How to watch videos on your television:

1. **SmartTV Browser:** Though televisions come in all kinds of brands, in general smart televisions typically come with a browser installed. Watching services on your television can be as easy as just using your TV's browser to navigate to the service you are wish to view! Once you are on the page in the television's browser, you just use your remote to click play! Once it begins, click the icon at the lower right to enter full screen:



2. **Streaming Devices:** Streaming devices like Firestick, Roku or Chromecast also work via this method, though each device has its own browsers. Below are a few tutorials on how to install browsers on your device:

3. **HDMI:** Probably the most straight-forward method, you can always use an HDMI or USB connection to directly connect your laptop to your television which would “mirror” what you have on your device on your television – basically using your TV like a big computer monitor.
