Introducing the JHELP Meal Delivery Program for Older Adults

Are you or your loved ones having trouble getting meals while staying home during the current health crisis? Your Jewish community is here for you.

The JHELP Meal Delivery Program is available for any older adult who needs help bringing fresh, healthy food into the house. Up to two meals per day will be delivered, free of delivery charge. See below for costs and eligibility.

The call center is open:

Monday through Thursday: 8am to 8pm

Friday: 8am to 5pm

Costs and Eligibility:

JHELP/Kosher Meals on Wheels program is for people over 60 years of age and those with disabilities in the tri-county area who need Kosher food and do not have other options for receiving support with their food needs. The food delivery service is free.

For those who do not qualify for government funding and may be unable to pay the full cost of the meal, costs will be subsidized by the Jewish Federation and our generous donors.

Please note: This meal delivery program is intended for older adults who otherwise lack the means to procure meals without leaving the house during the COVID-19 pandemic. We encourage those who do not require this service to refrain from registering so that we may direct resources to those in greatest need.
