

## Temple Beth Shalom Covid exposure protocol

Temple Beth Shalom takes all Covid related concerns very seriously. We do have means of assessing exposure risks and would like all concerns to go through proper channels. This can prevent confusion, provide reassurance, and guide individuals to proper decisions on how to handle possible risks.

If you or someone you know has a Covid risk or exposure, please do not come to Temple Beth Shalom until your risk has been clarified!

If you or someone you know has a risk of exposing someone at a Temple Beth Shalom activity, please contact TBS as soon as possible.

If you think you or someone you know may be at risk of Covid exposure from a TBS contact or activity, please contact TBS as soon as possible.

Although these concerns are not likely to be an emergency, they should be dealt with in a timely manner. Bear in mind that many concerns turn out to not be significant risk exposures. Correct evaluation of the situation is very important.

Please contact TBS first with concerns. Please do not spread misinformation about exposures and risks. Proper handling and notification of Covid issues is important to reassuring individuals and avoiding unnecessary anxiety and decisions.
